

Do you need help to pay for supportive living costs?

Contact Hennepin County to find out if you qualify for Medical Assistance and waiver funding to help senior citizens and people with disabilities pay for home health care, supportive living costs, medication reminders, homemaking and other similar expenses.

Who qualifies?

If your assets are less than \$10,000, call **612-348-4500** to ask for a consultation on longterm care waiver funding, and information on how to apply for Medical Assistance. To access waiver funding you must be assessed in-person and determined to be eligible.

You should know

- Medical Assistance alone **does not cover** the costs of assisted living or other supportive services. You must also apply for waiver funding.
- Assisted living payments can begin after the in-person long term care consultation if you found are eligible. Waiver funding cannot be retroactive.
- If your assets change (examples: house sold, inheritance, death of a spouse) and your services end, you will need to have a new long-term care consultation to resume services. Call 612-348-4500 to request another assessment.
- Some assisted living facilities may not accept waiver funding.
