Wayzata Boulevard reconstruction – Phase 2

Minnehaha Creek Watershed District permit application

The Minnehaha Creek Watershed District is reviewing the following permit application:

17-181: Hennepin County has applied for a Minnehaha Creek Watershed District permit for Erosion Control, Wetland Protection, and Waterbody Crossings and Structures for Phase 2 reconstruction of Wayzata Boulevard (County Road 112) between Wolf Pointe Trail and Myrtlewood Road in the Cities of Long Lake and Orono. The project will result in 0.124 acres of temporary wetland impact and 0.345 acres of permanent wetland impact that will be mitigated through the Board of Water and Soil Resources Local Government Road Wetland Replacement Program. The project will not result in upstream or downstream increases in flood stage. The area ultimately drains to Long Lake.

The Minnehaha Creek Watershed District's rules require notice of the proposed project as a courtesy, in the event there are any questions or concerns.
