Advisory Board Name	City Planning Commission (Minneapolis)
Origin	Originated in 1921 by City Charter, Chapter 13.
Duties/Responsibilities	The Planning Commission is charged with long-range planning for the City and is responsible for advising the City Council on matters of development, zoning, and capital improvements. It is a citizen's committee that works with the staff of the CPED-Planning Division on the development of plans and the review of development applications.
Composition	Five members of each of the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Hennepin County Commissioner Representative• City Council Representative• City Council Appointee• School Board• Park Board Four legal voters of the municipality (not members of any of the above bodies or boards) appointed by the Major with the approval of the City Council.
Term	Two years
Meetings	Approximately every other Monday at 4:30 PM in Room 317 of City Hall (the Council Chambers)
Eligibility Requirements	Must be a Minneapolis resident
Compensation	\$35 per mtg-max four mtgs a month
