| Advisory Board Name | Human Resources Board |
| Origin | The Personnel Board was originally created by Laws of Minnesota 1965, chapter 855, section 2. In 1994, Minnesota Statutes 383B.26 to 383B.42 were amended to establish a Human Resources Board. |
| Duties/Responsibilities | <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Establish rules for the classified service, subject to Hennepin County Board approval.● Make investigations pursuant to the Human Resources Act (Chapter 383B) or the Human Resources Rules.● Hear and decide appeals within its jurisdiction.● Submit an annual report to the County Board on the activities of the Human Resources Department. |
| Composition | Seven members, appointed by the County Board |
| Term | 4 years |
| Meetings | The board regularly meets on the first Wednesday of each month in the Human Resources Department, A400 Government Center, Minneapolis. The board may hold additional meetings, as necessary. |
| Eligibility Requirements | According to the Human Resources Act, Laws of Minnesota 1994, chapter 596, section 383B.28, subd. 2, a member <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Must not be a public official or candidate for public office.● Must not be a Hennepin County employee or within one year of becoming an employee.● Must not hold a position in a political party, except as a delegate.● Must reside in Hennepin County and forfeit the office if the member becomes a non-resident. |
| Compensation | Maximum \$50 per day for board meetings and for other activities, as authorized by the County Board; parking provided |
| Reimbursement | Mileage |
