



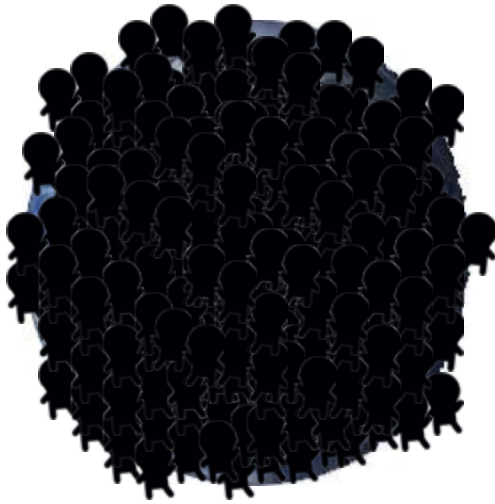

Approximate Number of Births During the Baby Boom Years: 1946-1964

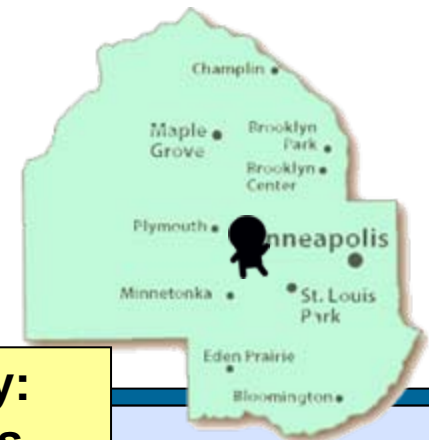

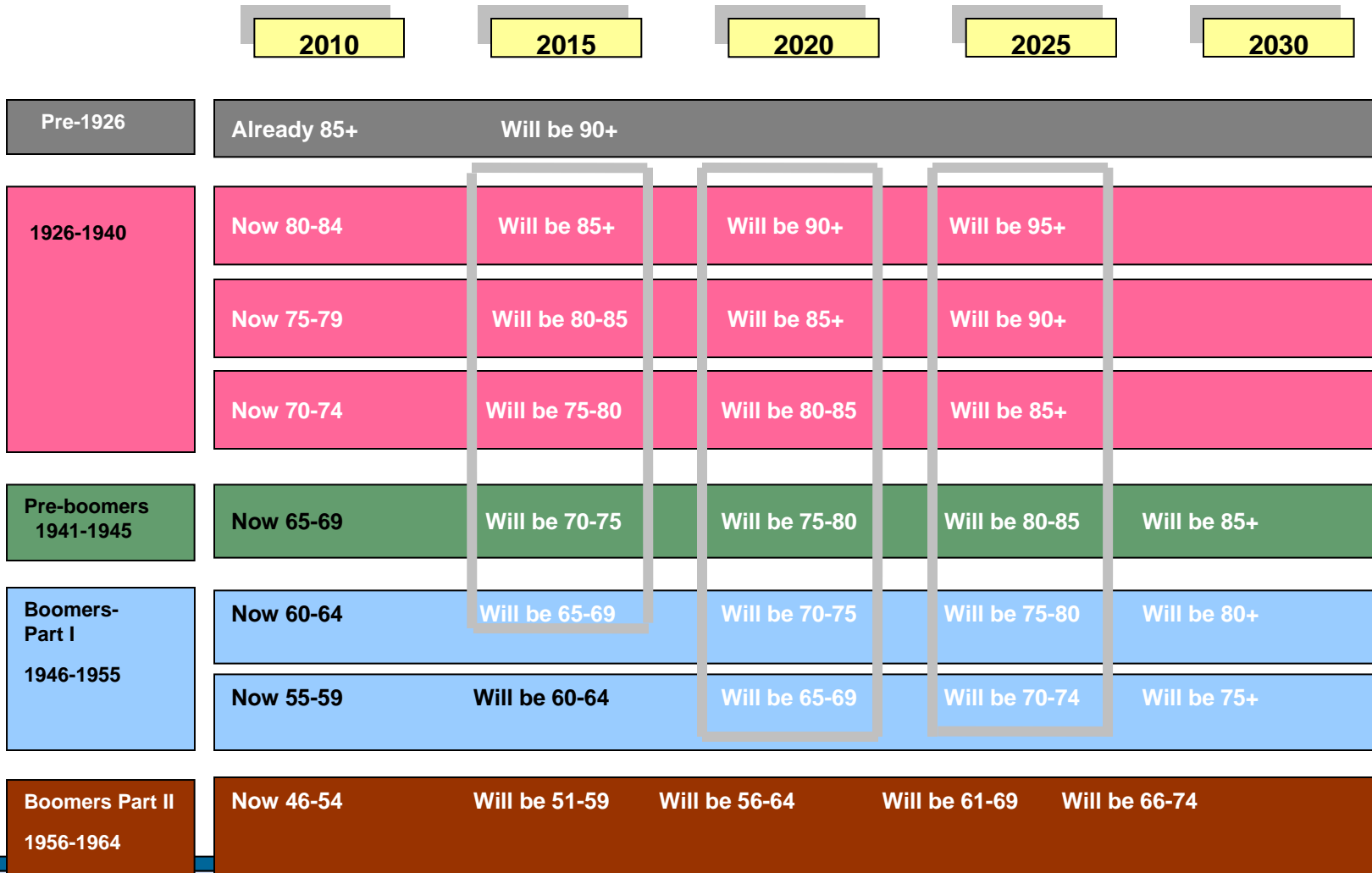

- Develop a prioritized research agenda aging

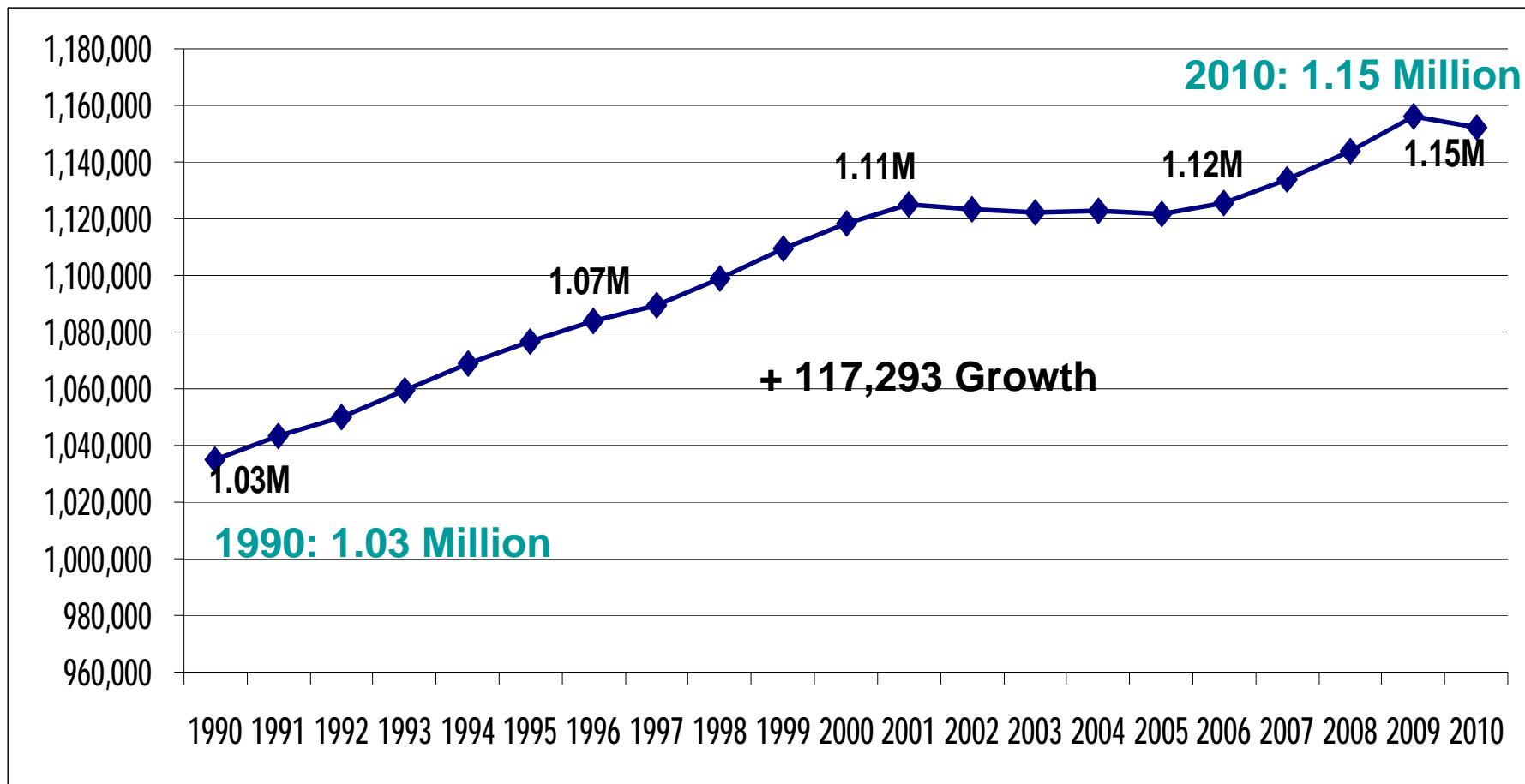

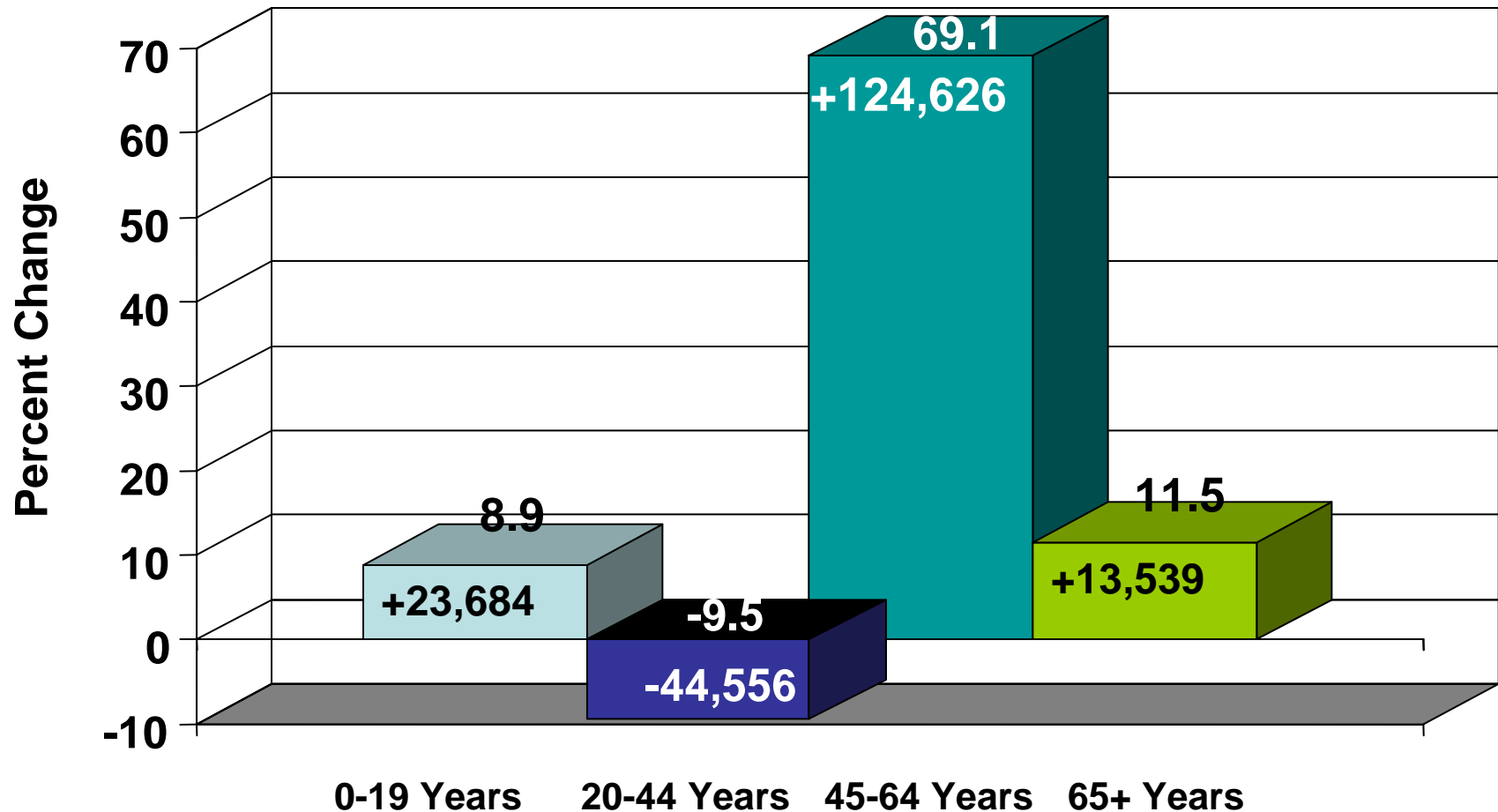

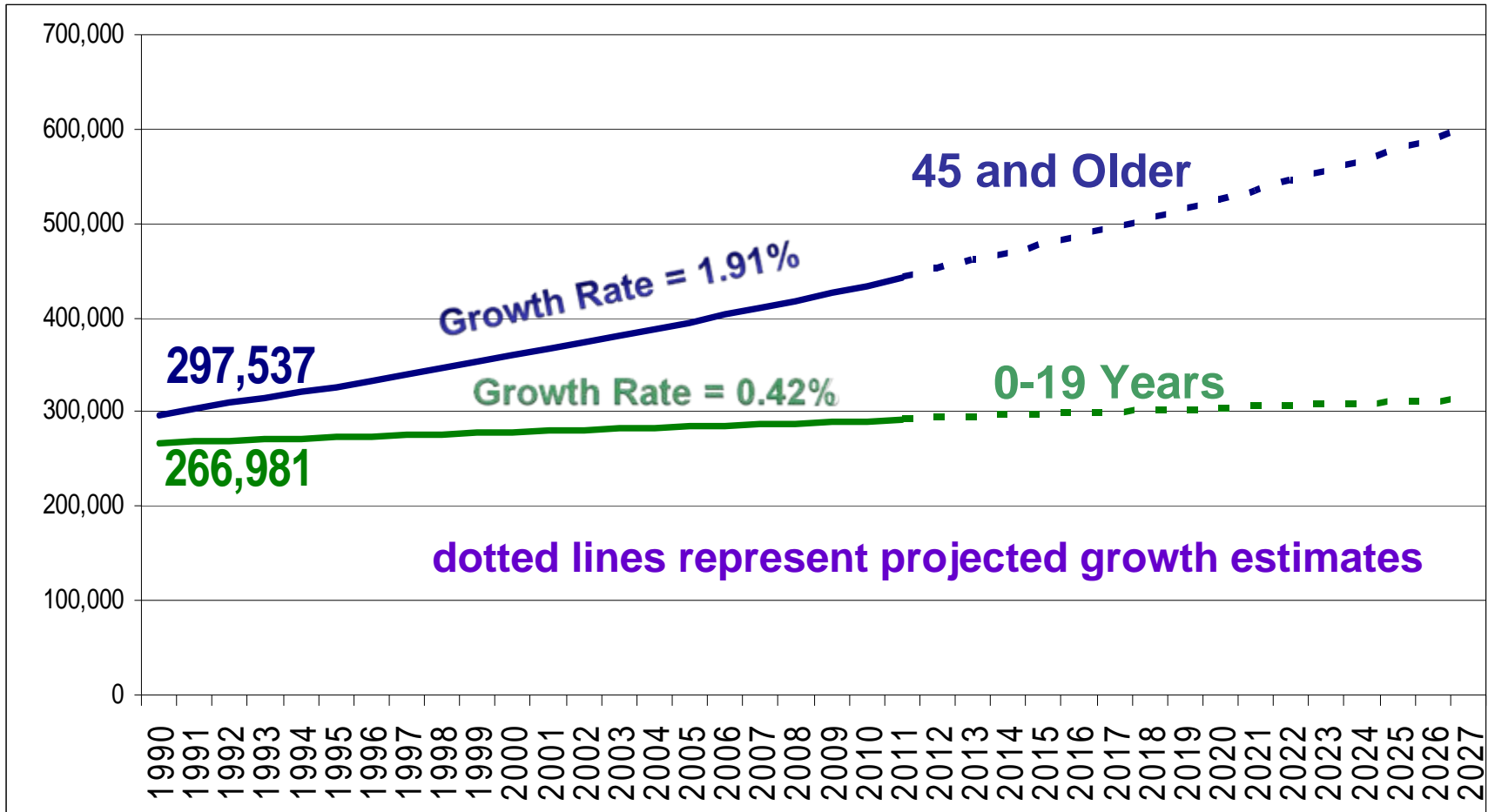
Hennepin County: Total Population 1990 - 2010



Hennepin County: Percent Change in Population 1990-2010 by Age Group



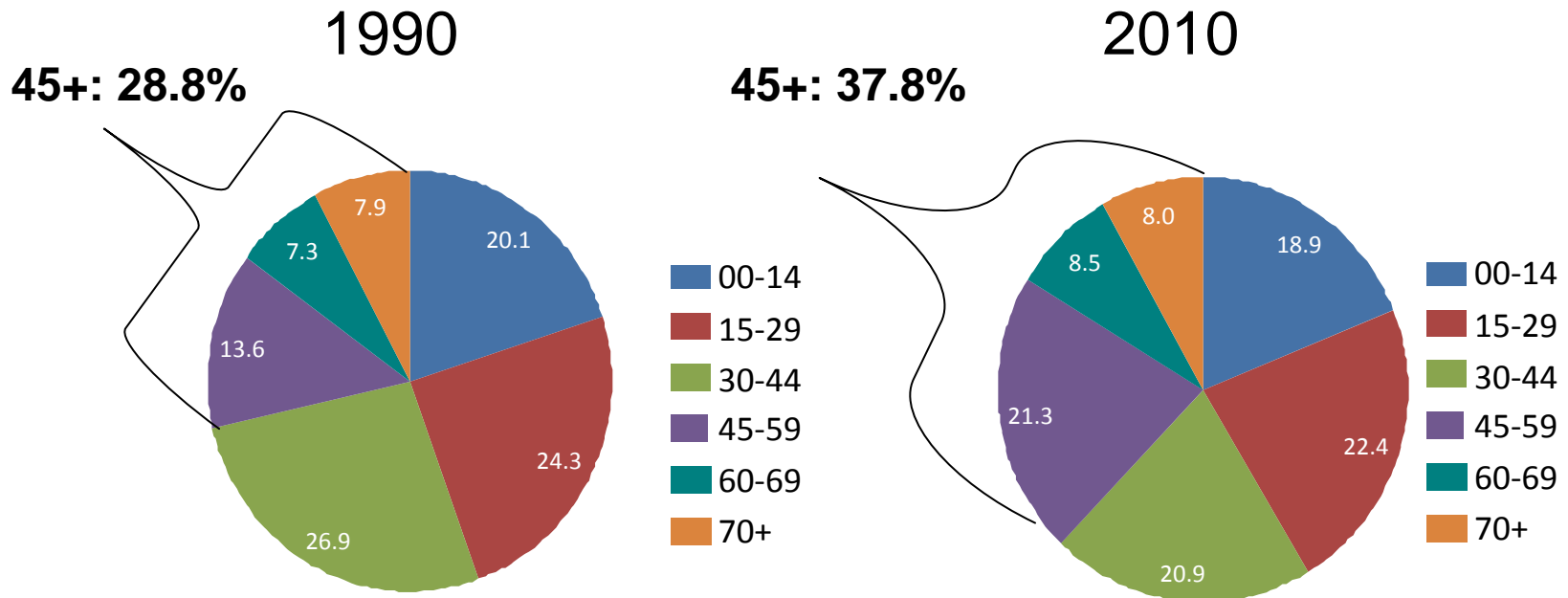
Hennepin County Population Growth: Selected Age Groups

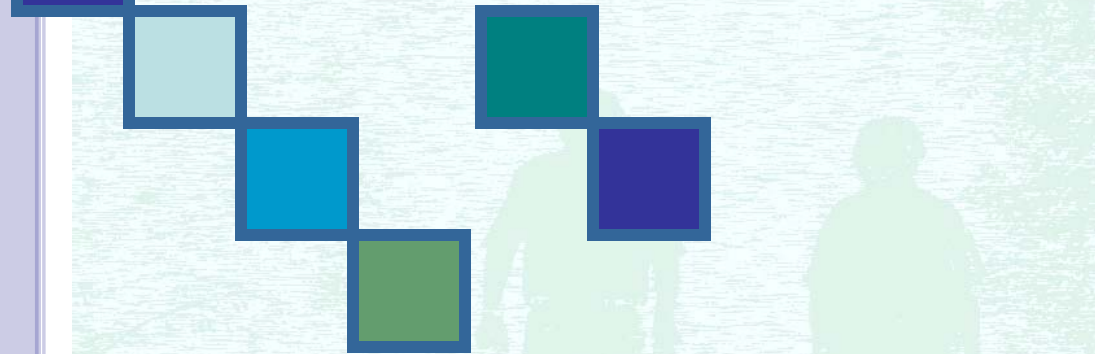

Hennepin County: Percent of Population by Age Group by Year

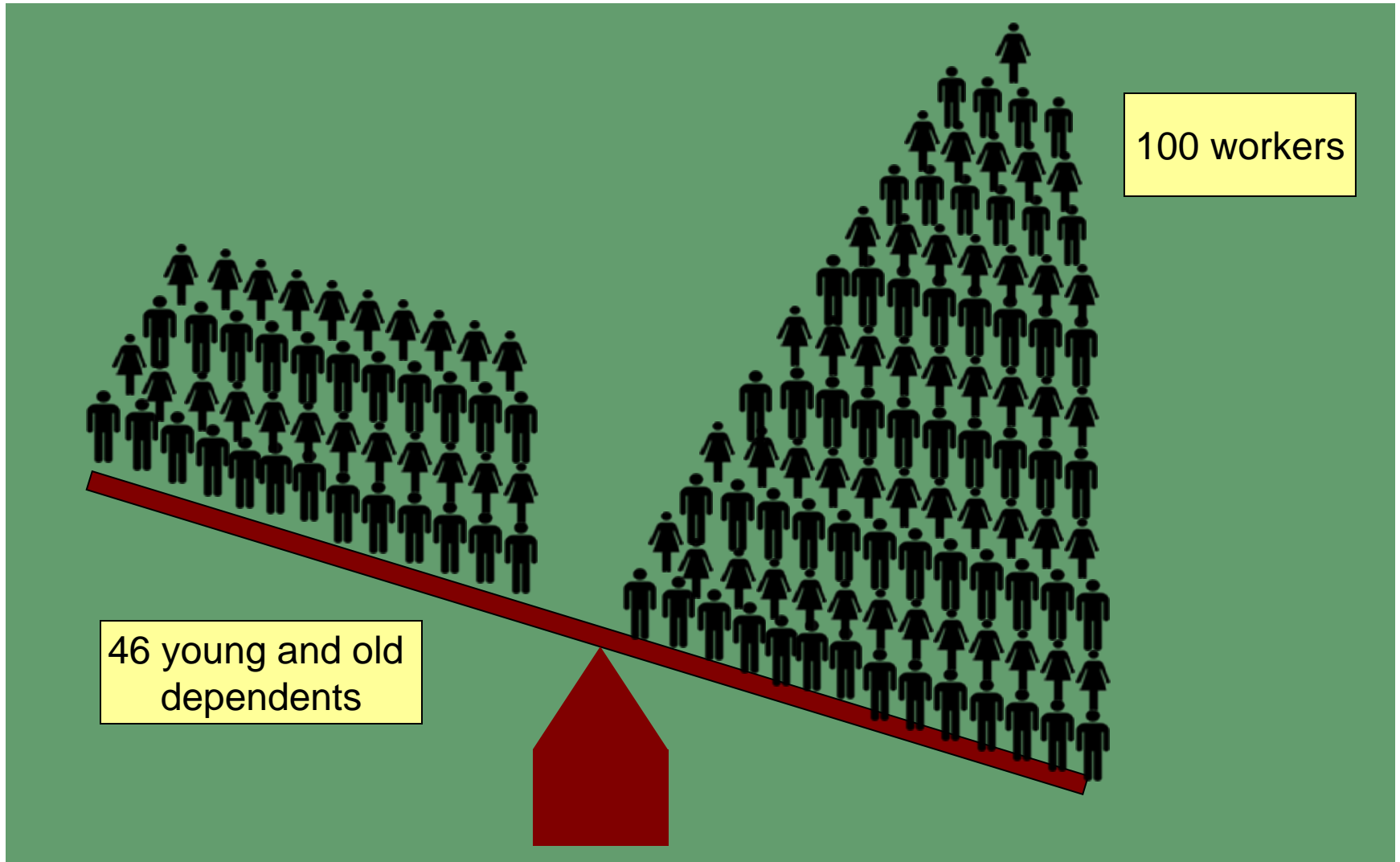

Age Dependency Ratios



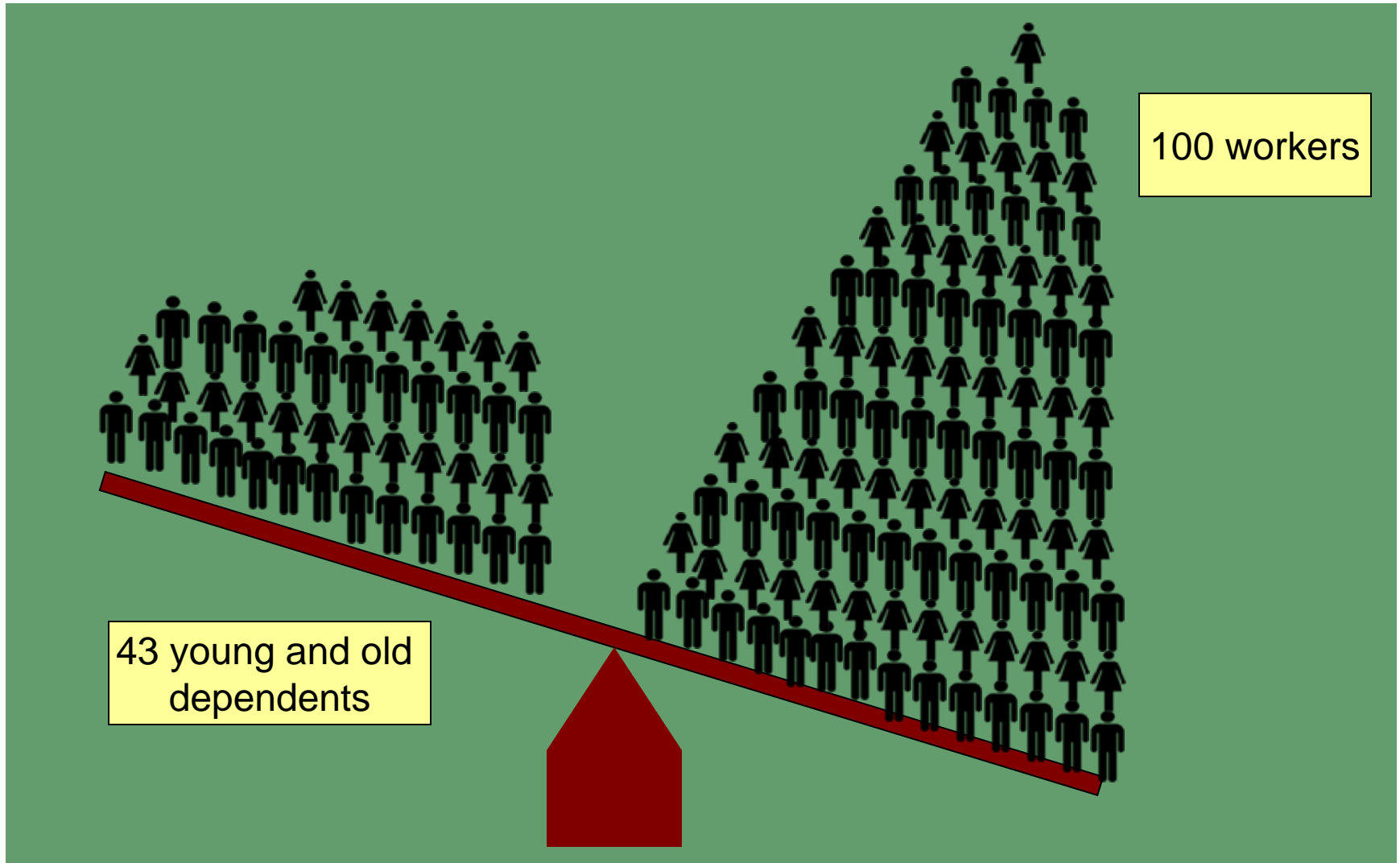
Hennepin County Age Dependency Ratio 1990

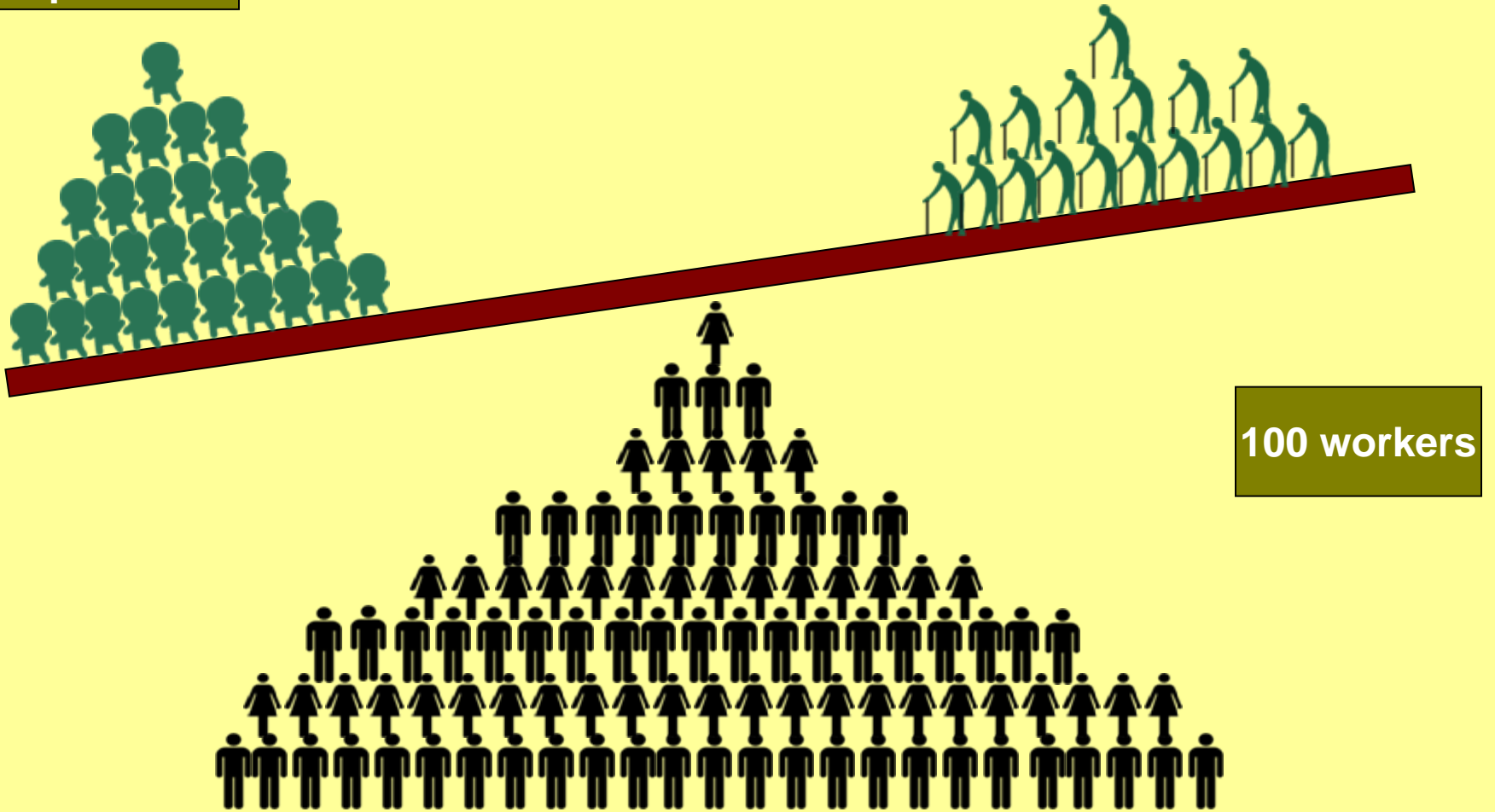

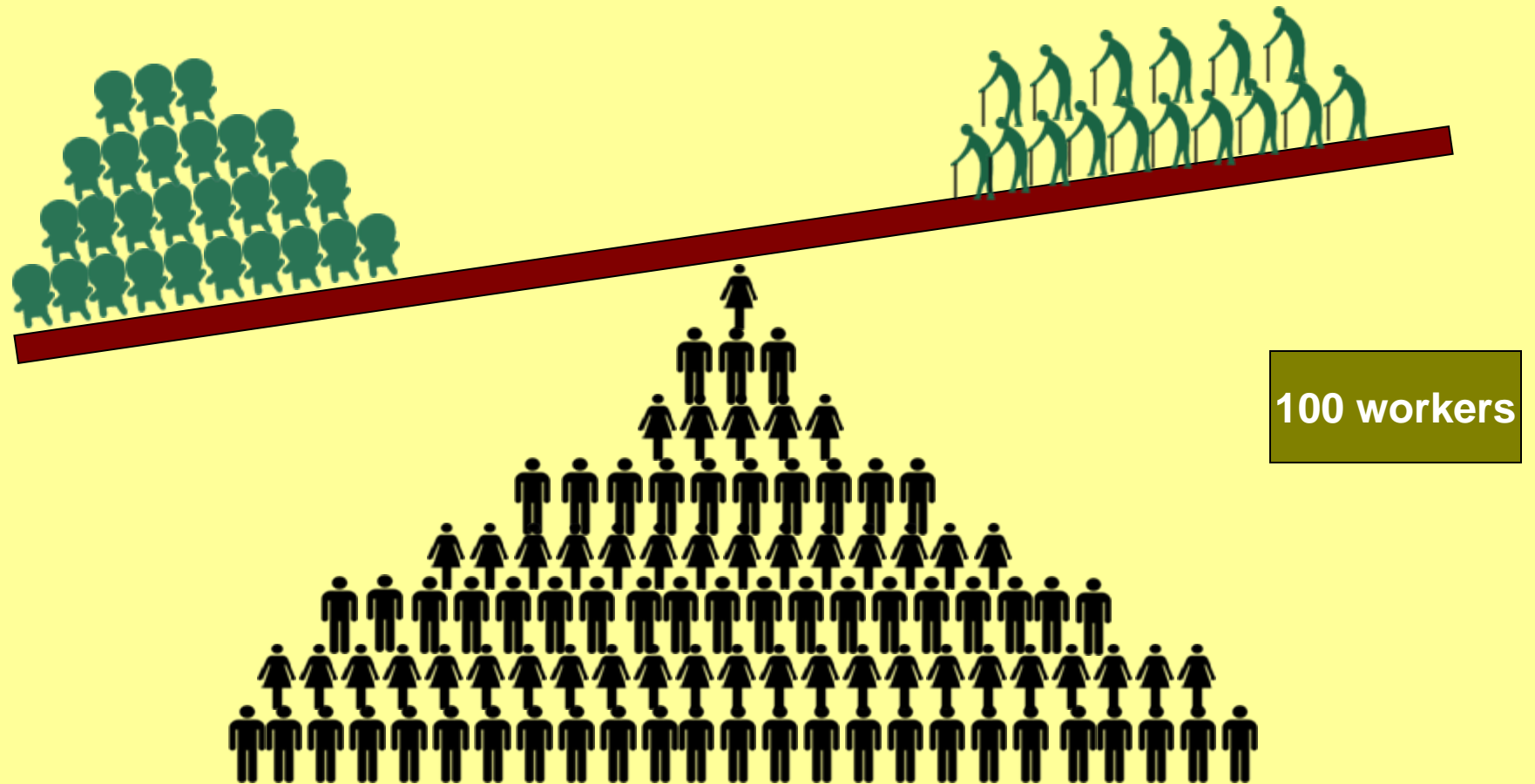

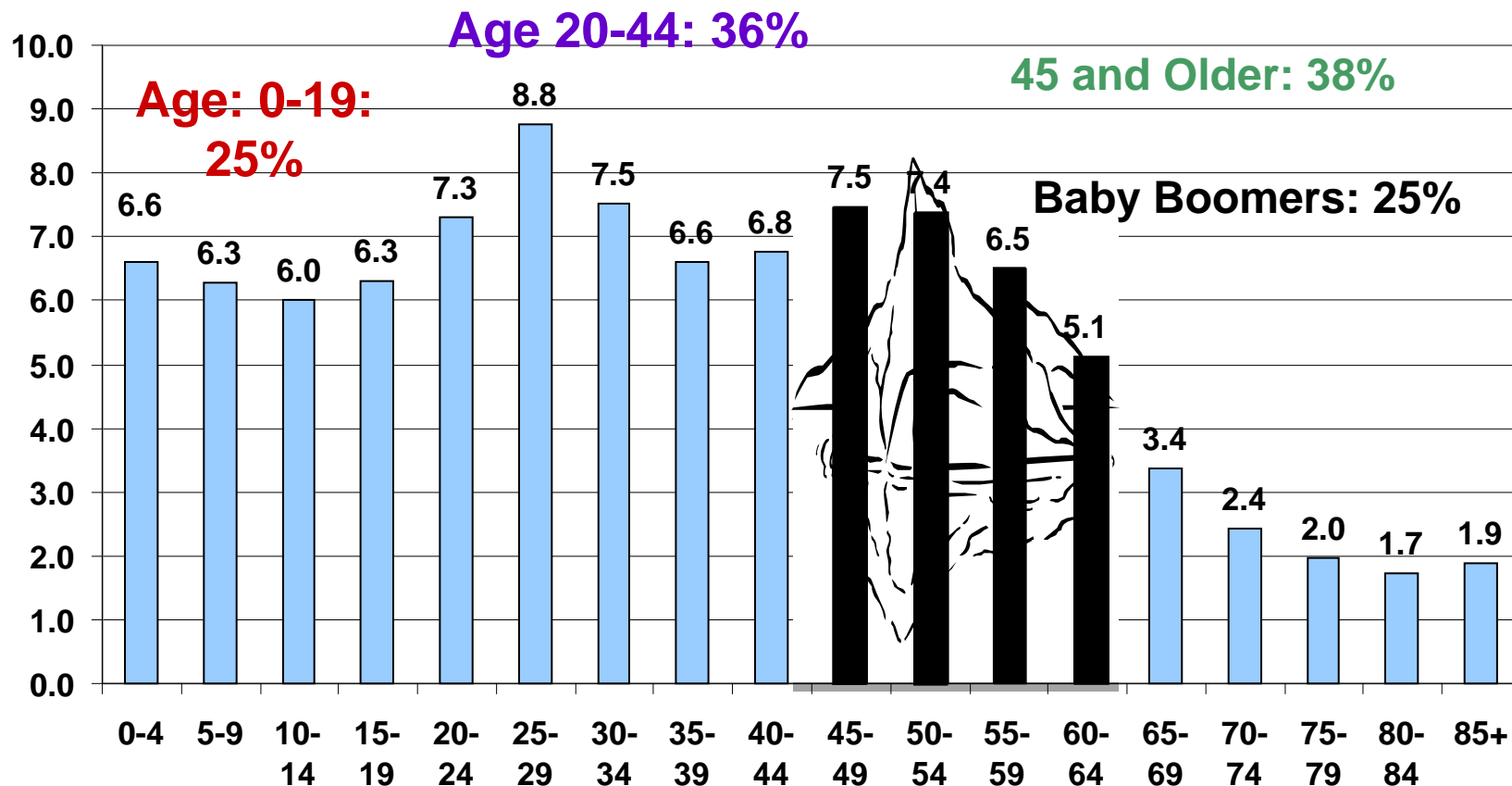

Hennepin County: Percent of 2010 Residents by Age Group Total Population=1,152,425



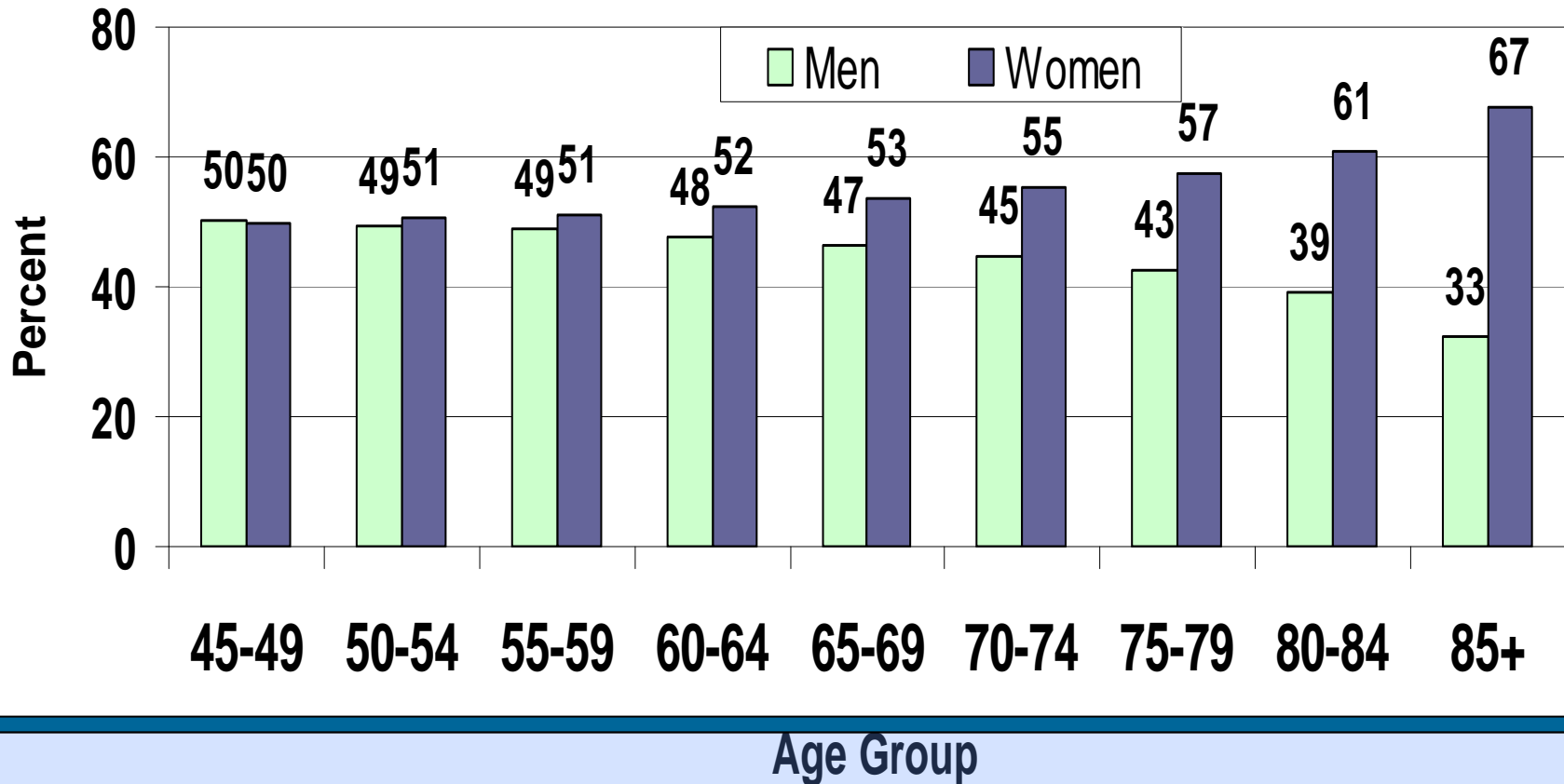
Hennepin County 2010: Sex by Age Group (n=435,702)

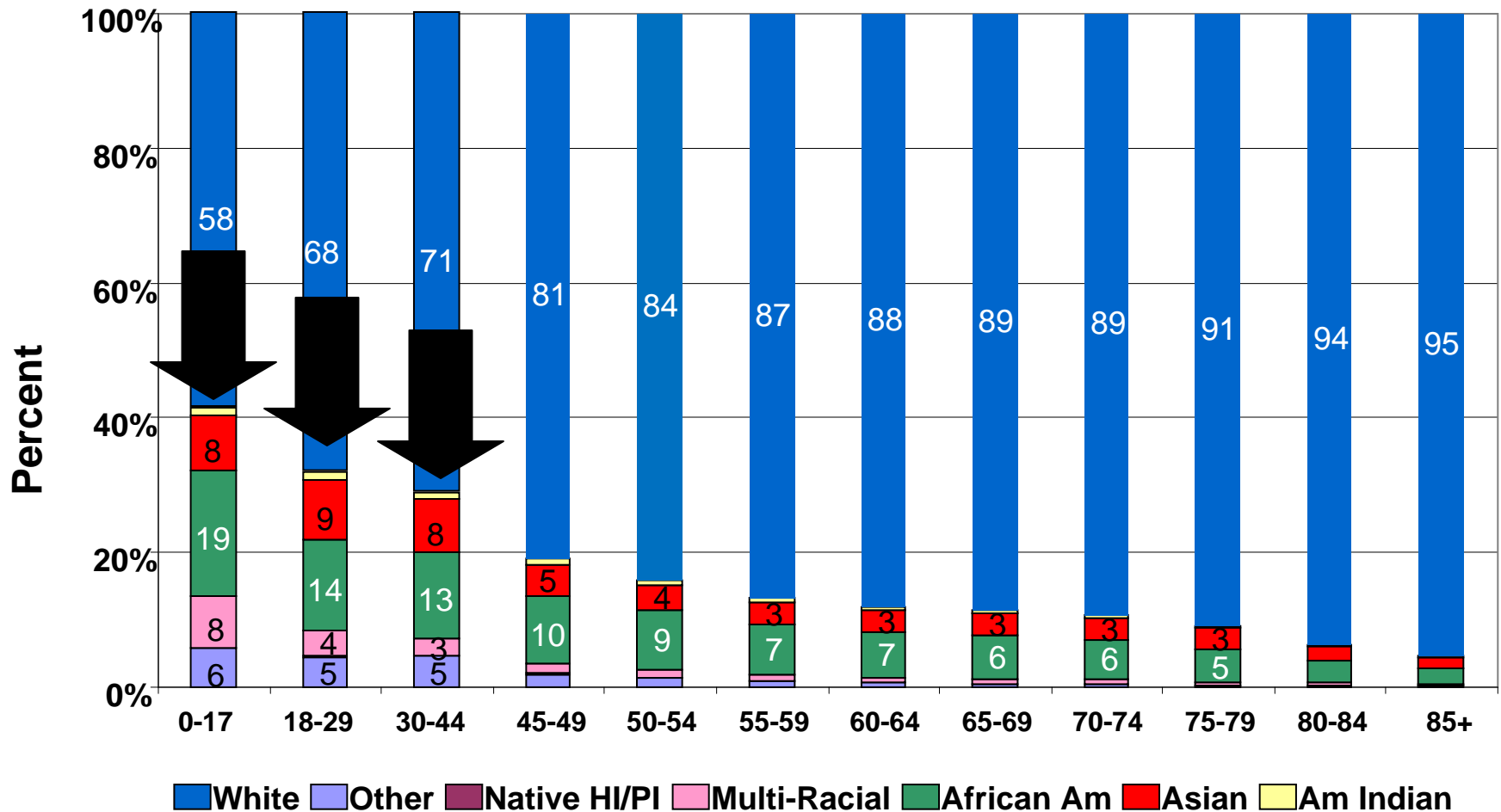

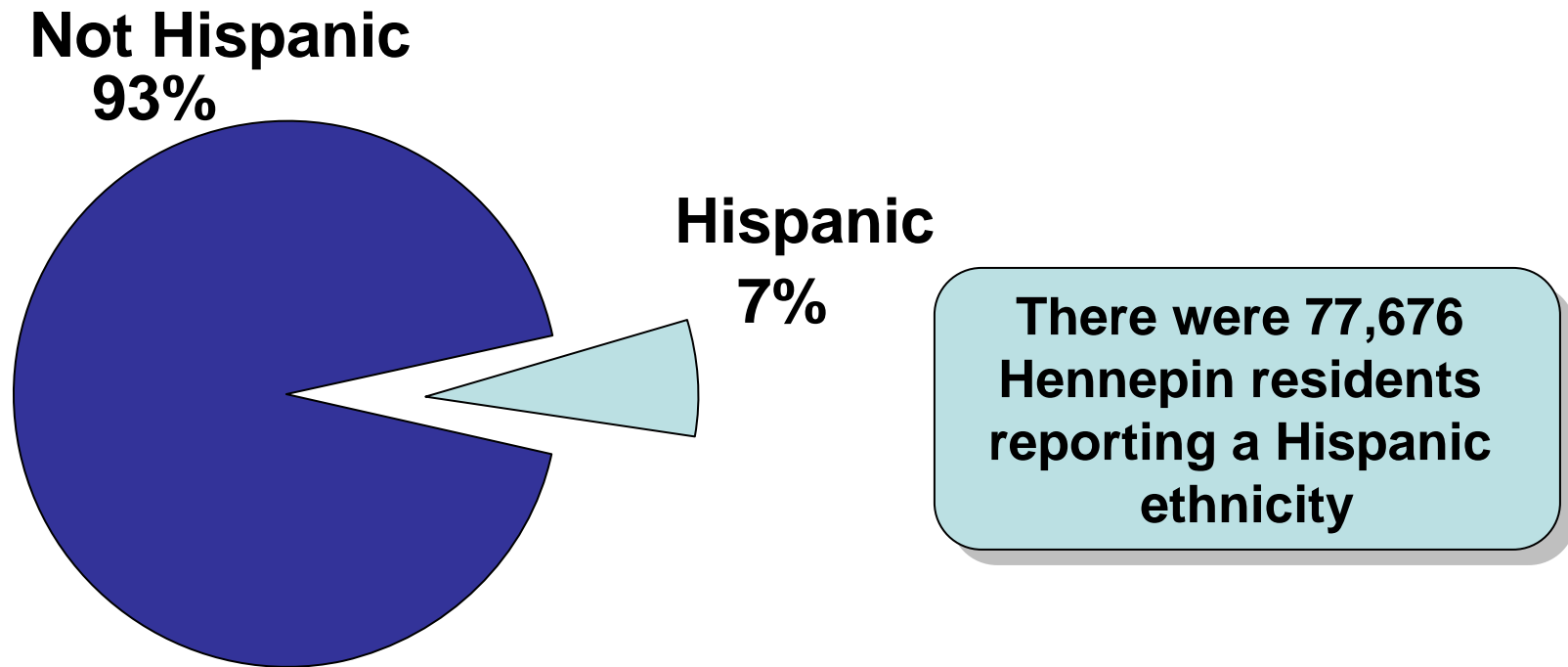

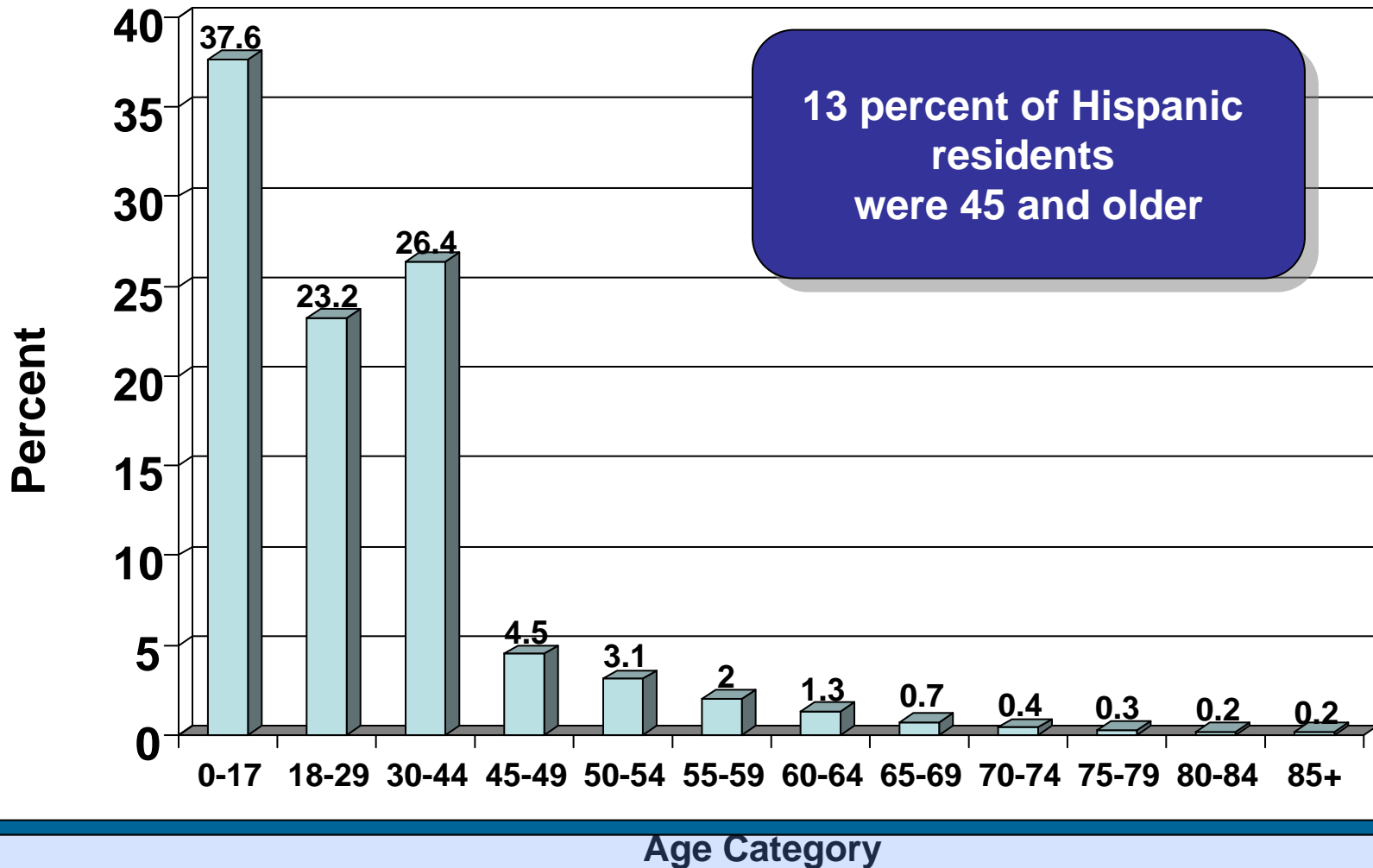
Hennepin County 2010: Race Categories for 2010 Population (n=1,122,261)



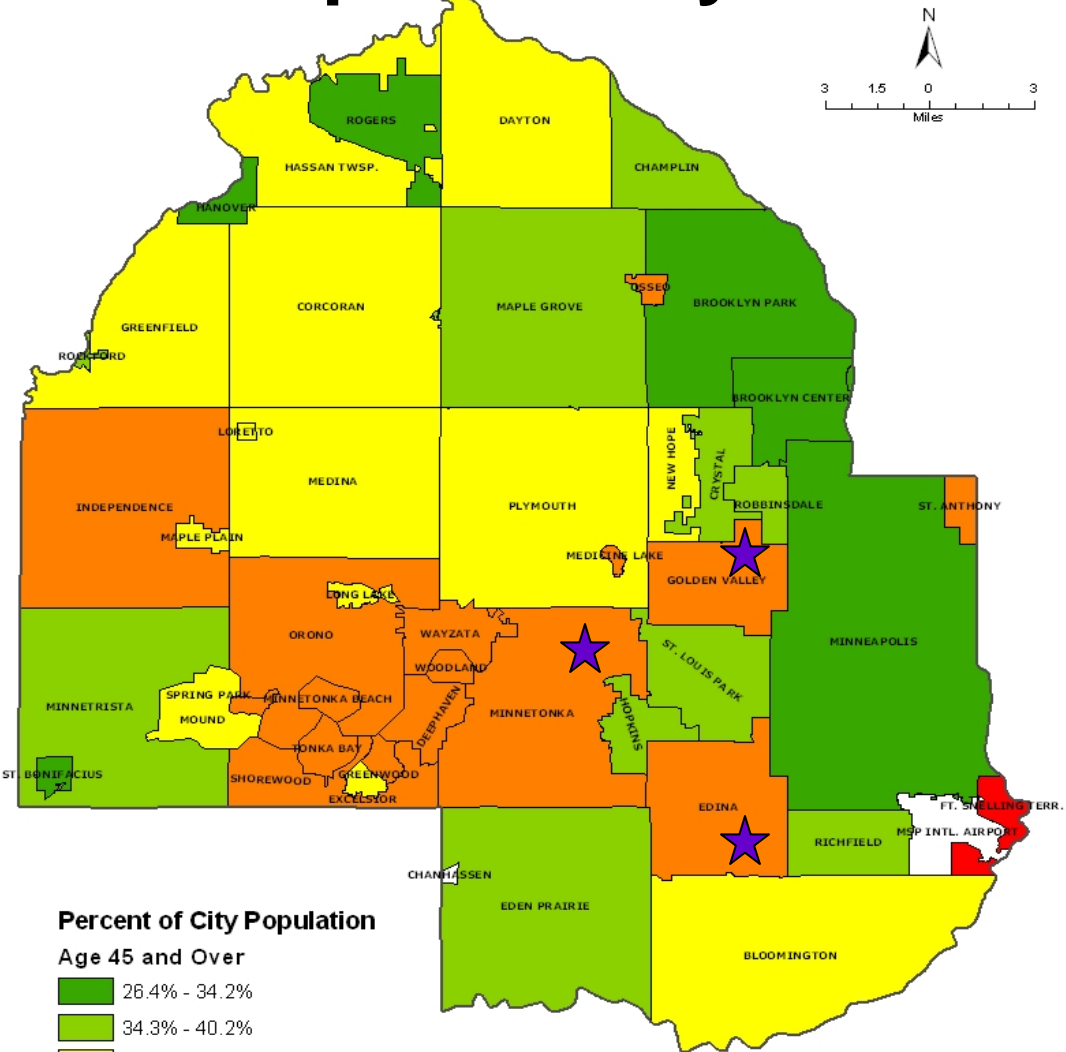
Hennepin County 2010: Percent Hispanic (N=1,152,425)
