What are the Hennepin County Service Centers?

Hennepin County Taxpayer Services manages a growing number of one-stop service centers that provide approximately 40 services, including:

- Driver’s license duplicates, renewals and reinstatements
- Driver’s permit renewals
- Motor vehicle tabs, plates, titles and registrations
- Birth and death certificates
- Marriage licenses and certificates
- Passports, including instant passport photos
- Minnesota state ID duplicates and renewals
- Notarizations
- Watercraft, snowmobile and ATV registrations

- State and federal waterfowl, trout, pheasant and goose stamps*
