Grants to fund projects that prevent waste in the business sector. Areas of focus can include reuse and recovery of goods and materials, food waste prevention, and packaging waste prevention.

| Application <br> timeline | Applications are accepted on an ongoing basis until <br> Monday, November 11, 2024 or until available funds are <br> depleted. |
| Amount of <br> funding <br> available | - Applicants may apply for up to \$50,000 <br> - Minimum of \$2,500 per project |
| Matching funds | All grants require $25 \%$ matching funds. <br> This requirement may be waived if the total fund <br> request is less than \$10,000 and includes purchases <br> of used items or equipment. |
| Project timeline | Grant term of up to 18 months. |
| Reporting | Must submit a final project report at least 30 days prior <br> to the expiration of the grant agreement. The report <br> requirements <br> must detail efforts made to achieve project goals and <br> the results of those efforts, including quantitative data, <br> referencing the baseline data and project expenditures. <br> A reporting template will be provided |
