What is this program?

This program assists parties in developing a co-parenting relationship and reducing their conflict to improve their child's well-being.

What does this program have to offer?

Co-Parent Education Workshops will:

- Address barriers to effective parenting
- Help each parent understand the important roles both mothers and fathers play in the life of their child
- Assist in the development of a healthy co-parenting relationship
- Develop an understanding of budgeting and raising a child
- Assist in understanding how to develop a parenting plan

All parents are required to attend the workshops which are held in North Minneapolis. There are four (4) workshops which are free of cost and offered during the evening.

Upon completion of the workshops, Hennepin County Family Court Services will meet with the mother and father to discuss and finalize a parenting plan, a type of agreement that may become a Court Order.

Other Supportive Services

As needs are identified, other supportive services can also be provided. This may include mother/father individualized support, education, employment, housing, mental health, and domestic violence.
