What services are available?

- Case management services to work on concerns/issues identified by families and single adults
- Referrals to mediation to resolve landlord/tenant disputes
- ➤ Referrals to legal assistance for representation in landlord/tenant disputes
- Cash assistance to help stabilize housing

Who is eligible?

- Anyone who lives in Hennepin County
- Living in a rental unit, either as the lease holder or are on someone else' lease
- Concerned about being evicted or unable to pay rent
