
Habitat conservation project

Little Long Lake

Little Long Lake consistently has the best water quality in the metro area. Our protection and restoration efforts will ensure that Little Long Lake remains ideal for fishing and swimming forever.



Project features

- Protects nearly 3,000 feet of shoreline along Dutch Lake and Little Long Lake.
- Adds 130 acres to more than 550 acres of already permanently protected habitat including existing conservation easements and property owned by Three Rivers Park District.
- Represents the complete connection of Long Lake, Little Long Lake, and Dutch Lake.
- Contains high-quality upland forest, ephemeral forest wetlands, wet meadows, marshland, and streams.
- Has documented occurrences of fish and plant species of concern and is part of the DNR's Wildlife Action Network Areas.
- Results from neighbor and community driven conservation efforts.
- Plans to enhance the maple-basswood forest on all five projects.
