
Existing Deficiencies

- No dedicated Aquatic Invasive Species (AIS) decontamination facility
- Traffic flow and ramp not optimized for modern vehicles/trailers
- Poor and non-ADA accessible shore fishing experience
- Worn asphalt paving and deteriorated stormwater systems
- Limited accessibility for recreational boaters with a disability









Lake Minnetonka North Arm Public Access

Proposed Improvements

- Dedicated space for Aquatic Invasive Species (AIS) prevention actions and permanent decontamination facility
- Optimized traffic flow and parking for larger vehicles and trailers
- Wider ramp standard for Lake
 Minnetonka with straight backing
- Enhanced and ADA accessible shore fishing experience
- New grid-previous parking spaces and stormwater management
- Access improvements assisting non-motorized watercrafts, such as kayaks, canoes, and paddleboards
- Wheelchair ramp and lift

Milestones

- Planning commission meeting 11/17/2025
- City council meeting 12/08/2025
- Construction documents Q1 2026
- Contractor procurement/bidding Q2 2026
- Construction commencement Q3 2026

Note: Construction will be done in phases and will prioritize maintaining public access during the busiest portion of the fishing and boating season.
