



## Lake Minnetonka North Arm Public Access

### Existing Deficiencies

- ① No dedicated Aquatic Invasive Species (AIS) decontamination facility
- ② Traffic flow and ramp not optimized for modern vehicles/trailers
- ③ Poor and non-ADA accessible shore fishing experience
- ④ Worn asphalt paving and deteriorated stormwater systems
- ⑤ Limited accessibility for recreational boaters with a disability





# Lake Minnetonka North Arm Public Access

## Proposed Improvements

- 1** Dedicated space for Aquatic Invasive Species (AIS) prevention actions and permanent decontamination facility
- 2** Optimized traffic flow and parking for larger vehicles and trailers
- 3** Wider ramp standard for Lake Minnetonka with straight backing
- 4** Enhanced and ADA accessible shore fishing experience
- 5** New grid-previous parking spaces and stormwater management
- 6** Access improvements assisting non-motorized watercrafts, such as kayaks, canoes, and paddleboards
- 7** Wheelchair ramp and lift
