Accessible Absentee Ballot

Hennepin County has an accessible absentee ballot available for voters. Voters who have impaired vision or print disabilities can request an accessible ballot by emailing HC.vote@hennepin.us. Voters requesting the accessible ballot must also apply for a regular absentee ballot. A web link to the accessible ballot will be emailed to the voter, while the absentee envelopes and other materials will be mailed to the voter's address.

Voters who receive an accessible ballot are able to fill it out with their computer's assistive technology. Once the voter fills out the ballot, they will need to print it and mail it back with the provided absentee envelopes.

Follow these steps to request, complete, and return your accessible absentee ballot.

1. Request your absentee ballot by either filling out an [online application](#) or return a [paper application](#). To request an application in Braille, please call 1-877-600-8683.
2. Email HC.Vote@Hennepin.us and ask that your absentee ballot be sent as an accessible ballot.
3. Hennepin County Elections will email you a link to the accessible ballot and mail you the absentee ballot envelopes.
4. After receiving your accessible ballot follow the on-screen instructions to mark your ballot with your choices, then print your ballot.
5. Take your printed ballot and assemble the absentee envelopes. Following the instructions complete the signature envelope including a witness signature. You may need assistance assembling the envelopes. Once assembled return your ballot to Hennepin County.

Completed ballots must be returned by Election Day. You can track the status of your ballot at mnvotes.org/trackmyballot.
