Elections Timeline

Midterm primary

- June 26: Absentee voting begins for State Primary
- July 21: Primary deadline to pre-register to vote
- August 10: In-person absentee voting closes at 5 p.m.
- August 11: Primary Election Day (polls open 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.)

Midterm general election

- September 18: Absentee voting begins for the General Election
- October 13: General election deadline to pre-register to vote
- November 2: In-person absentee voting closes at 5 p.m.
- November 3: General Election Day (polls open 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.)

Voting absentee

Apply for an absentee ballot

Absentee voting begins September 18, leading up to the general election on November 3. Make sure you're prepared! Complete an absentee ballot application online at mnvotes.gov/absentee

General Absentee messages

Absentee voting begins September 18

Absentee voting for the general election starts on September 18! Vote early by mail or early in-person. mnvotes.gov/absentee

Track your absentee ballot

Request an absentee ballot

Your ballot needs to arrive by Election Day to be counted. Haven't mailed it? Return your ballot in-person or drop-off. Ballots returned by hand must be received by 5:00 p.m. on Election day:

Check your status

Pre-register to vote

Make sure you pre-register to vote! The deadline to pre-register for the Midterm Election is October 13. <http://mnvotes.gov/register>

Missed the pre-registration deadline?

Missed the pre-registration deadline for the November 3 midterm election? No worries, you can still register on Election Day at your polling place. Be sure to bring proper identification.
