

RADON WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW **WHAT YOU NEED TO DO**

The Environmental Protection Agency says elevated radon levels are likely to be found in one of every three Hennepin County homes - both new and old. The first step toward "clearing the air" in your home is finding out if elevated levels of radon are present and, if so, your current level of exposure.

A **short-term test kit** is a good way to do this. These kits are available at home improvement centers and on the Internet. Hennepin County Public Health Protection offers them directly to county residents at a discounted price of **\$9.00**, or two for **\$17.00**. The price includes lab analysis and a report of the results.

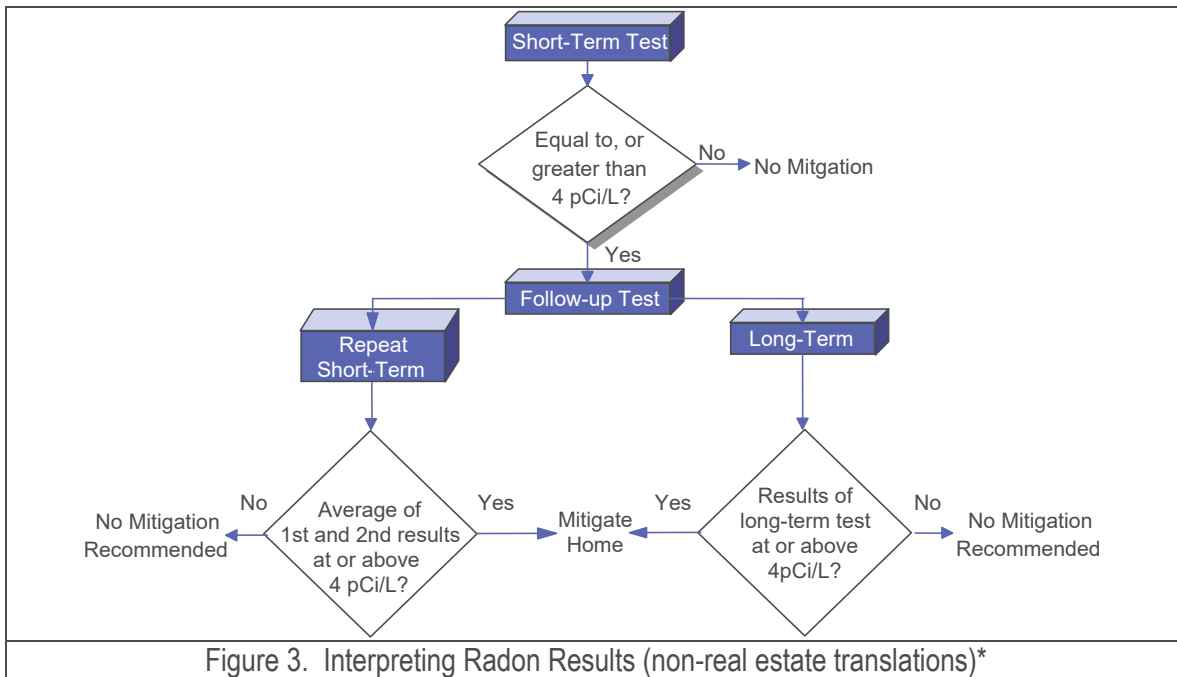


Figure 3. Interpreting Radon Results (non-real estate translations)*
