

Where to Report Suspected Abuse or Neglect

Immediate Danger: Call 911

No Immediate Danger

For alleged maltreatment committed by:

A parent, guardian, family child care provider, family foster care provider, or juvenile correctional facility staff person.

A staff person at a child care center, residential treatment center (children's mental health), group home for children, minor parent program, shelter for children, chemical dependency treatment program for adolescents, waived services program for children, crisis respite service program for children, or residential service program for children with developmental disabilities.

A staff member or other person in a home health care setting, hospital, regional treatment center, nursing home, or immediate care facility for persons with developmental disabilities.

An employee of a public pre-school, elementary school, middle school, secondary school, or charter school when the child is a student in the school.

A person who is outside of the family and not a staff person at a facility (e.g., athletic club staff, babysitters)
