## **EDUCATOR'S STATEMENT**

Minn. Stat. § 517.08 subd. 1b(c)-(d)

Minnesota law provides for a reduced marriage license fee when a couple completes 12 hours of premarital education. "The premarital education must be provided by a licensed or ordained minister or the minister's designee, a person authorized to solemnize marriages under section 517.18, or a person authorized to practice marriage and family therapy under section 148B.33." Minn. Stat. § 517.08 subd. 1b(c). To obtain the reduced fee, applicants must provide a statement from the educator **at the time of application**. The statement must meet the following requirements:

- 1. Statement must be on the educator's letterhead
- 2. Statement must be signed and dated by the educator, with the educator's signature notarized or "marked" with a church seal
- 3. Statement must include legal names of both applicants and these names must be identical to the names on the marriage application
- 4. Minnesota law (Minn. Stat. § 517.08 subd. 1b(d)) specifically requires the following language be used in the Educator's Statement:
