You are hereby notified that the Hennepin County Director of Resident and Real Estate Services Department, acting in the capacity of Hennepin County Auditor-Treasurer, has scheduled a meeting for the purpose of classifying or reclassifying Tax-Forfeited Lands situated in the County of Hennepin. The County Auditor-Treasurer is acting under delegation of statutory authority, power and responsibility granted in accordance to Minnesota Statutes, section 282.135 by the Board of Hennepin County Commissioners. The lands described on Proposed Conservation and Non-Conservation Classification List 2089-CNC will be reviewed during the meeting.

The list of Hennepin County tax-forfeited lands subject to review at the meeting can be found in the **Classification process** drawer/drop-down on the hennepin.us/taxforfeitedland page. The process for classifying or reclassifying tax-forfeited lands was changed by the 2010 Minnesota Legislature. The Legislature also made significant changes to the statutes governing the conditional use deeds that municipalities may use to acquire tax-forfeited lands for public use. The meeting for the purpose of classifying or reclassifying Tax-Forfeited Lands situated in the County of Hennepin has been scheduled as follows:
