



PROJECT BACKGROUND AND NEED

CSAH 101 serves as a major north-south roadway in the cities of Wayzata, Woodland and Minnetonka. Increases in traffic along the CSAH 101 corridor have compromised traffic operations and safety.

Hennepin County has been systematically improving CSAH 101 to address these issues. This project includes the segment of CSAH 101 between US Hwy 12 (Wayzata Boulevard) and CSAH 5 (Minnetonka Boulevard). Hennepin County Public Works and their consultant URS Corporation have started project development activities in conjunction with City staff from Wayzata, Minnetonka, and Woodland. As the project develops, County and consultant staff will work closely with individual property owners to get input on the design relative to their property. This will be in addition to the public involvement activities for the communities at large.
