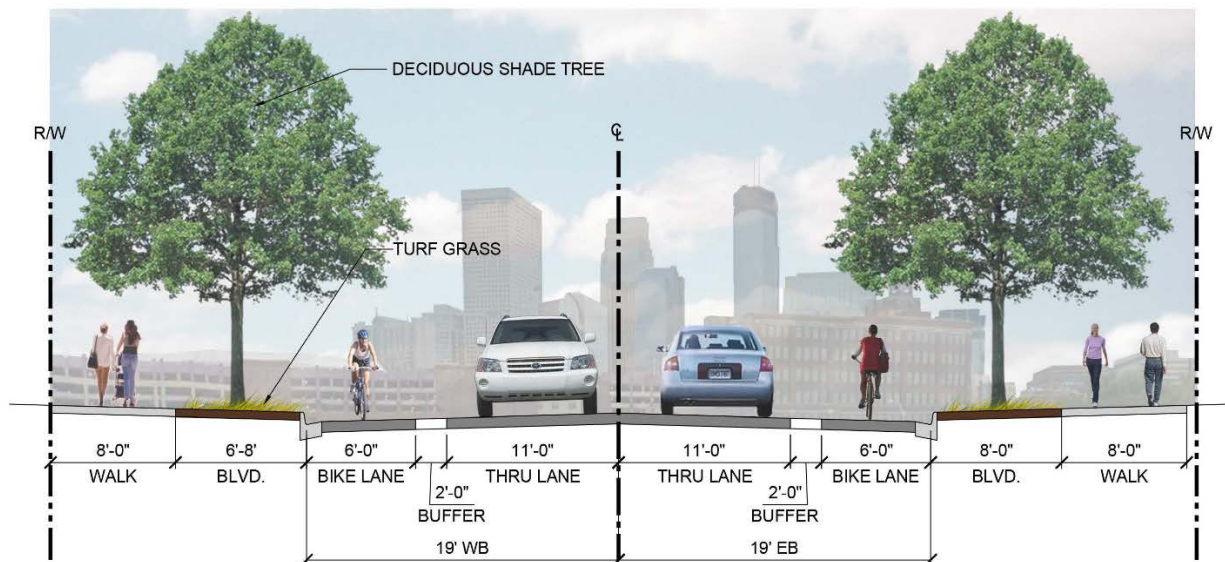
Hennepin County, in partnership with the City of Minneapolis and Metropolitan Council, is developing a preliminary design plan for the improvement of Glenwood Avenue (County Road 40) between Aldrich Avenue and Seventh Street.

Current roadway characteristics

- 2-lane urban with on-road striped bike lanes and sidewalks
- Traffic volumes (2016): 2,400 – 8,000
- Bike volumes (2014): 310
- Pedestrian volumes (2014): 870
- Bus Route 9 (2012): 2,555
- Posted speed: 30 mph
- Land use: primarily commercial, industrial

Project purpose and need

- Improve pedestrian and bicycle connectivity for transit ridership at future Royalston light rail transit (LRT) station
- Strengthen connections to nearby neighborhoods by improving facilities, streetscapes and street crossings for pedestrians and bicyclists
- Create a corridor allowing for redevelopment as a dense multi-use commercial corridor
- Accommodate the Southwest LRT bridge reconstruction by Metropolitan Council
- Improve road condition (pavement quality)

- Preliminary design: 2016
- Community input: 2016
- Detail design and construction: to be coordinated with Southwest LRT construction
