


Mill Street pathway project



OVERVIEW

Hennepin County, in coordination with the cities of Excelsior, Shorewood and Chanhassen, is leading a project to construct a multi-use pathway alongside Mill Street (County Road 82) from 2nd Street in downtown Excelsior to Holly Lane. The pathway will provide a key connection for users of the existing Chanhassen pathway to downtown Excelsior and create a safer way to walk, bike or roll along Mill Street.



COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT GOALS

This project aims to achieve the following during our engagement efforts:

- Identify and evaluate pathway options
- Seek public feedback to help determine the preferred pathway option
- Create an initial pathway design and high-level cost estimate for future consideration

● Summer 2023

Initial pathway design presented to public and local municipalities for approval

● Late 2023/Early 2024

Final pathway design and additional public engagement

● Summer 2025



Mill Street pathway project




Pathway option 1

The majority of option 1 includes pavement resurfacing of Mill Street and the addition of a 10-foot pathway separated from the street by a 6-foot grassy boulevard.



Pathway option 2

The majority of option 2 includes pavement resurfacing of Mill Street and the addition of a 10-foot pathway separated from the street by a 6-foot grassy boulevard and 4-foot bikeable shoulders.
