

Minnetonka Boulevard reconstruction

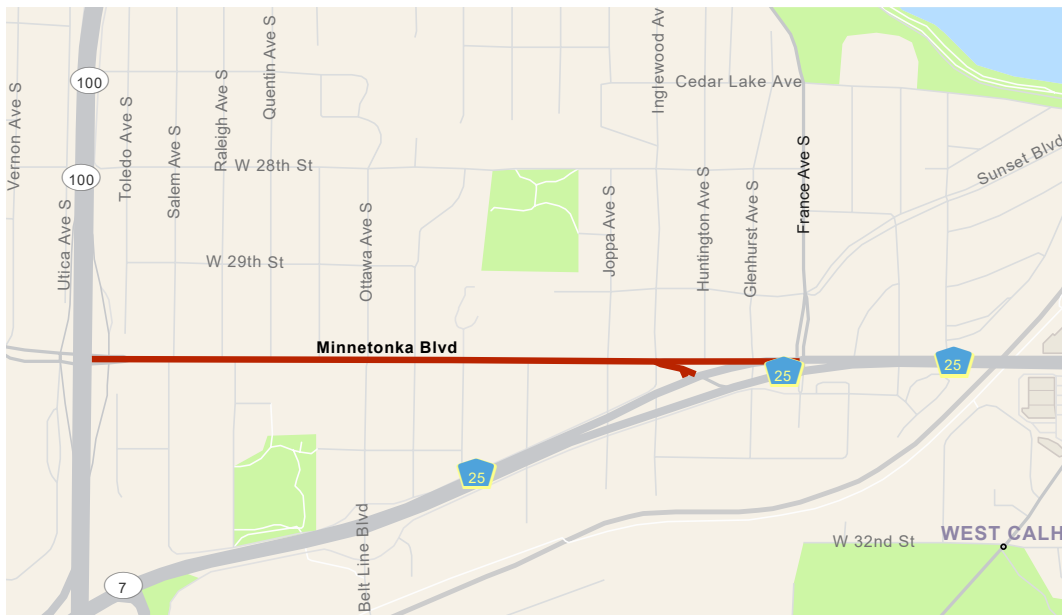
County Road 5 in St. Louis Park

Project overview

Hennepin County is reevaluating the current use and design of Minnetonka Boulevard between Highway 100 and France Avenue, and is developing a plan for the corridor to better serve current and future users.

Initial considerations include:

- Lane reconfigurations and realignments
- Improved connections for people biking, walking, and rolling to the Beltline Boulevard and West Lake Street light rail stations
- Enhancements for people walking and rolling
- Accommodations for people biking
- Streetscape improvements
