

# Project Overview

- Reconstruct County Road 61 (Flying Cloud Drive) from Highway 101 to Charlson Road
- Construction includes:
  - Two-lane roadway with shoulders
  - Center left-turn lane
  - Right-turn lanes at key intersections
  - Multi-use trail on the north side of the roadway
- Goals are to:
  - Replace the existing pavement
  - Improve safety
  - Minimize transportation disruptions caused by seasonal flooding of the Minnesota River
- The project is in the early stages of development. Additional public meetings will be held summer/fall 2013 as part of the Municipal Consent Process.
- Project Partners include Hennepin County, MnDOT, Carver County, the City of Eden Prairie, and the City of Chanhassen.

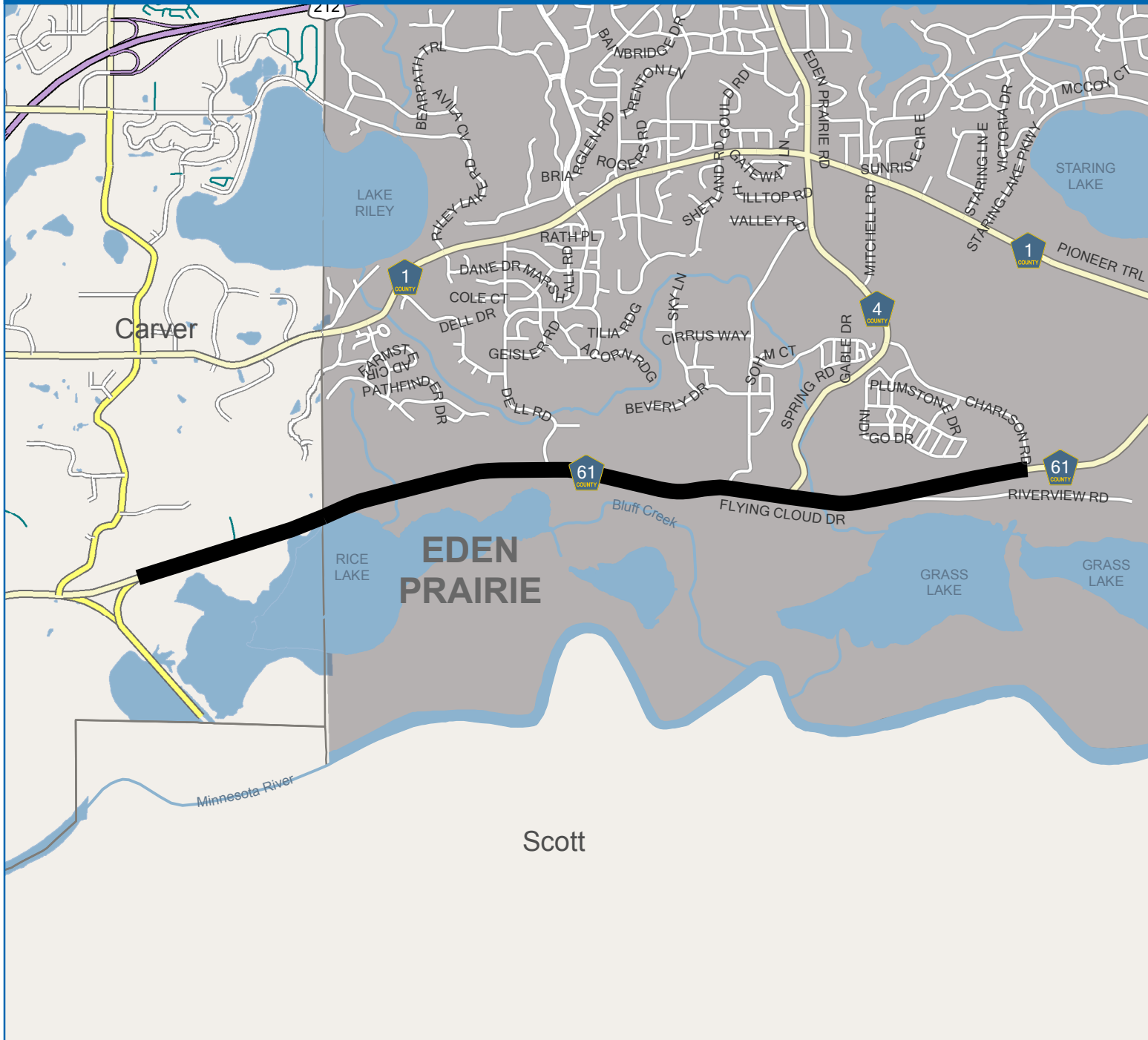

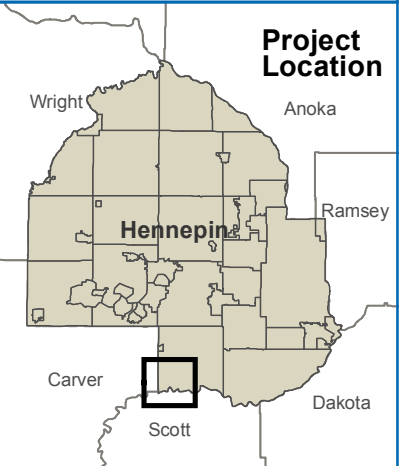
