# University and Fourth roadway improvements: phase two community engagement summary

## **About this project**

In June and July of 2021, the University and Fourth project team, led by Hennepin County, conducted in-person and virtual public engagement to solicit feedback and educate the public on two potential project concept options. Engagement activities included a virtual open house platform and survey, a pop-up event at 15th and University Avenues, two neighborhood meetings, a meeting with the University District Alliance, and promotion to residents, local business, student groups, university groups, and local government agencies.



# **Demographics**

A little more than **75 percent** of respondents identified their race/ethnicity to be Caucasian/White, about **6 percent** identified as Asian, **2 percent** identified as Latinx, **2 percent** identified as Black/African American, and the remaining respondents identified as "Other" or preferred not to answer.
