Project overview

The county is currently in the process of developing detailed design plans for roadway and trail improvements for the second phase of reconstruction, which is anticipated to begin in 2018. Phase 1 reconstruction, from Willow Drive to Wolf Pointe Trail, is scheduled to begin in 2017. Separate communications and community outreach about phase 1 construction will begin soon.
