CSAH 112 – Phase 2 Project Advisory Committee (PAC) Meeting September 22, 2016 (8:00-10:00 a.m.) Orono City Hall MEETING RECORD

A project PAC meeting for the referenced project was held at the Orono City Hall on September 22, 2016 from 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. The following is a summary of the meeting based on the Agenda, which is attached to this record:

4. Discussion Items (60 Minutes)

a. Trail Extension

- Nate Will presented a layout with the potential trail extension shown from Old Long Lake Road to the Luce Line Trail. A copy of the trail extension layout presented is attached to this meeting record.
- Jessica Loftus asked if SRF could provide an estimated cost for the trail extension if the City
 of Orono decided not to add the trail with the CSAH 112 project but at a separate time.
 - o Nate Will said cost would include extra for Curb & Gutter, grading, tree removal, and extra Right of Way.
 - O Kristy Morter mentioned adding the trail later, would require CSAH 112 to be revised from a rural section with a ditch to a curb & gutter with a boulevard, trail and storm sewer. She also mentioned that if the trail is added, the boulevard area would be maintained by the adjacent property owners.
 - Nate Will added that SRF has not yet done a full design of the trail. In preliminary review of the trail we have identified a few areas that need further study. If the City and County decide to add the trail extension these areas will need to be evaluated. The areas have been identified are impacts to the adjacent wetland, possible retaining wall along the outside curve just east of Old Long Lake Road and impacts to the proposed pond at Old Long Lake Road and CSAH 112.
- Dan MacDonald asked about the need for ROW for the trail.
 - O Kristy Morter noted that Hennepin County land acquisition staff have researched the property ownership and are confident a trail could be constructed across the parcel (NE corner of CSAH 112 at Luce Line Trail) at no cost for right of way to the City of Orono or County.
 - O Nate Will mentioned that a small sliver of additional right of way would be needed from the two residential properties (970 & 920 Wayzata Blvd) for the trail.
- Mayor McMillan added that the trail extension would create a nice loop. She would like to bring the trail extension to the Orono City Council for discussion.
- Kristy Morter mentioned the trail extension could be presented at either a council meeting or a work session for both Cites for discussion prior to the open house. She added that the County is seeking a motion of support from the City of Orono before it is added to the project.
- Nate Will added that a decision on the trail extension is needed very shortly to allow SRF time to incorporate the design into the 60 percent plans.

b. Green Hill Lane Right-in/Right-Out vs. Left-Right-in/Right-out

 Nate Will presented a graphic for a modified median at Green Hill Lane that would allow left and right turns in and only right turns out. A copy of the graphic presented is attached to this meeting record.

- Dan MacDonald added that he sees a lot of traffic go to Russell Lane to take a left out onto CSAH 112 and avoid using Green Hill Lane.
- Dale Lemmerman also added that Green Hill Lane has limited sightline to the east which makes a difficult left turn.
- Mayor McMillian would like to see the option be brought to the open house.
- Nate Will concluded that SRF will show the right-in right-out geometry dashed and show the
 presented graphic geometry on the layout for the open house.

c. Wayzata Blvd/CSAH 112/TH 12 Ramp Intersection

- Nate Will presented a graphic of the sight distance evaluation with photos looking both toward the east and west. A copy of the graphic presented is attached to this meeting record.
- Dan MacDonald stated that there is a manhole in the berm area between the TH 12 westbound ramp and the City of Wayzata maintenance facility. Added that if the manhole could be lowered maybe the slope could be regraded (lowered) to improve the sight distance. Also, he noted the existing road sign should be relocated to help with sight distance.
- Kristy Morter stated that this area is within MnDOT right of way and discussion with MnDOT is needed about possibly regrading, adjusting a manhole, and moving the sign.
- Nate Will added that we are reducing the size of this intersection and are looking at pavement marking "stop bar" locations to further improve the sight distances.
- Kristy Morter noted a review of past 3-year crash history reported 5 crashes at this intersection.

d. Staging

- Amber Klein described three basic staging options: full road closure, one lane of traffic, or two lanes of traffic. Based upon the concerns expressed in Phase 1, the options of closing the road for construction and only having one lane of traffic open would not be considered viable in Phase 2...
- Amber Klein presented a graphic depicting a two lane construction option with temporary pavement needed to accommodate the two way traffic. A copy of this graphic is attached to this meeting record.
- Kristy Morter noted that the speed limit is planned to be reduce to 30 MPH during construction and that most of the construction should be completed in 1 year.
- Nate Will added that there would still need to have some road closures for City of Long Lake utility replacement needs. These will be added to the layouts for the open House.

e. Public Open House - Date TBD, October 2016

 Lake Community Bank is under construction and we will not be able to have Open House there.

- Long Lake Fire Station is a good alternative. Scott Weske will inquire about availability for the Open House.
- The PAC agreed to schedule the Open House for Thursday, October 27th from 4:30 pm to
 6:30 pm if the date and time is available at the Fire Station.




