Origin

Originated in 1921 by City Charter, Chapter 13.

Composition

Ten members

- The Mayor (or designee)
- Four legal voters of the municipality (not members of any of the below bodies or boards) appointed by the Mayor, with the approval of the City Council

A member of each of the following:

- Hennepin County Commissioner Representative
- City Council Representative
- City Council Appointee
- School Board
- Park Board

Duties/Responsibilities

The Planning Commission is charged with long-range planning for the City and is responsible for advising the City Council on matters of development, zoning, and capital improvements. It is a citizen's committee that works with the staff of the Community Planning and Economic Development-Planning Division on the development of plans and the review of development applications.

Term

Two years

Meetings

Approximately every other Monday at 4:30 PM in Room 317 of City Hall (the Council Chambers)

Eligibility Requirements

Must be a Minneapolis resident

Compensation

\$35 per meeting-max four meetings a month
