

Committee Summary

Origin

The Personnel Board was originally created by Laws of Minnesota 1965, chapter 855, section 2. In 1994, Minnesota Statutes 383B.26 to 383B.42 were amended to establish a Human Resources Board.

Composition

Seven members, appointed by the County Board

Duties/Responsibilities

- Establish rules for the classified service, subject to Hennepin County Board approval.
- Make investigations pursuant to the Human Resources Act (Chapter 383B) or the Human Resources Rules.
- Hear and decide appeals within its jurisdiction.
- Submit an annual report to the County Board on the activities of the Human Resources.

Term

Term 4 years

Meetings

The board regularly meets on the first Wednesday of each month in the Human Resources Department, A400 Government Center, Minneapolis. The board may hold additional meetings, as necessary.

Eligibility Requirements

According to the Human Resources Act, Laws of Minnesota 1994, chapter 596, section 383B.28, subd. 2, a member:

Must not be a public official or candidate for public office.

Must not be a Hennepin County employee or within one year of becoming an employee.

Must not hold a position in a political party, except as a delegate.

Must reside in Hennepin County and forfeit the office if the member becomes a non-resident.

Compensation

Maximum \$50 per day for board meetings and for other activities, as authorized by the County Board; parking provided
