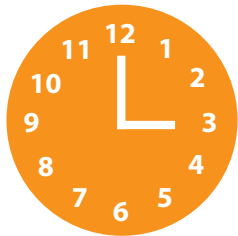

Hours



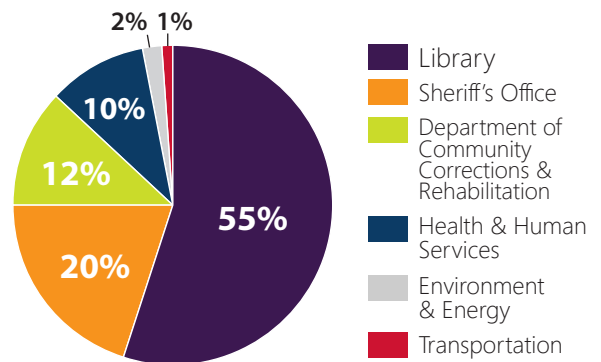
Citizens: 136,299

- Conducting the Wetland Health Evaluation program, Master Recycler/Composter program, and Fix-it-Clinics.
- Keeping our roads clean with our Adopt a Highway program.
- Providing bi-lingual customer service skills to support limited English proficiency clients.
- Greeting and directing building visitors to service areas.
- Assisting, supporting, and directing self-service clients to complete online job searches, applications, and more.
- Helping offenders make positive changes in their lives by leading activities and acting as a mentor or role model.
