HIV care services allow people living with the virus to lead healthy, vibrant lives. These services also stop the virus from spreading. HIV testing is an important tool to prevent new infections. Today's test results are available in five minutes. For little or no cost, residents can access HIV testing through primary care providers, community-based settings, private insurance, Medical Assistance, Medicare, and other public health insurance plans.
