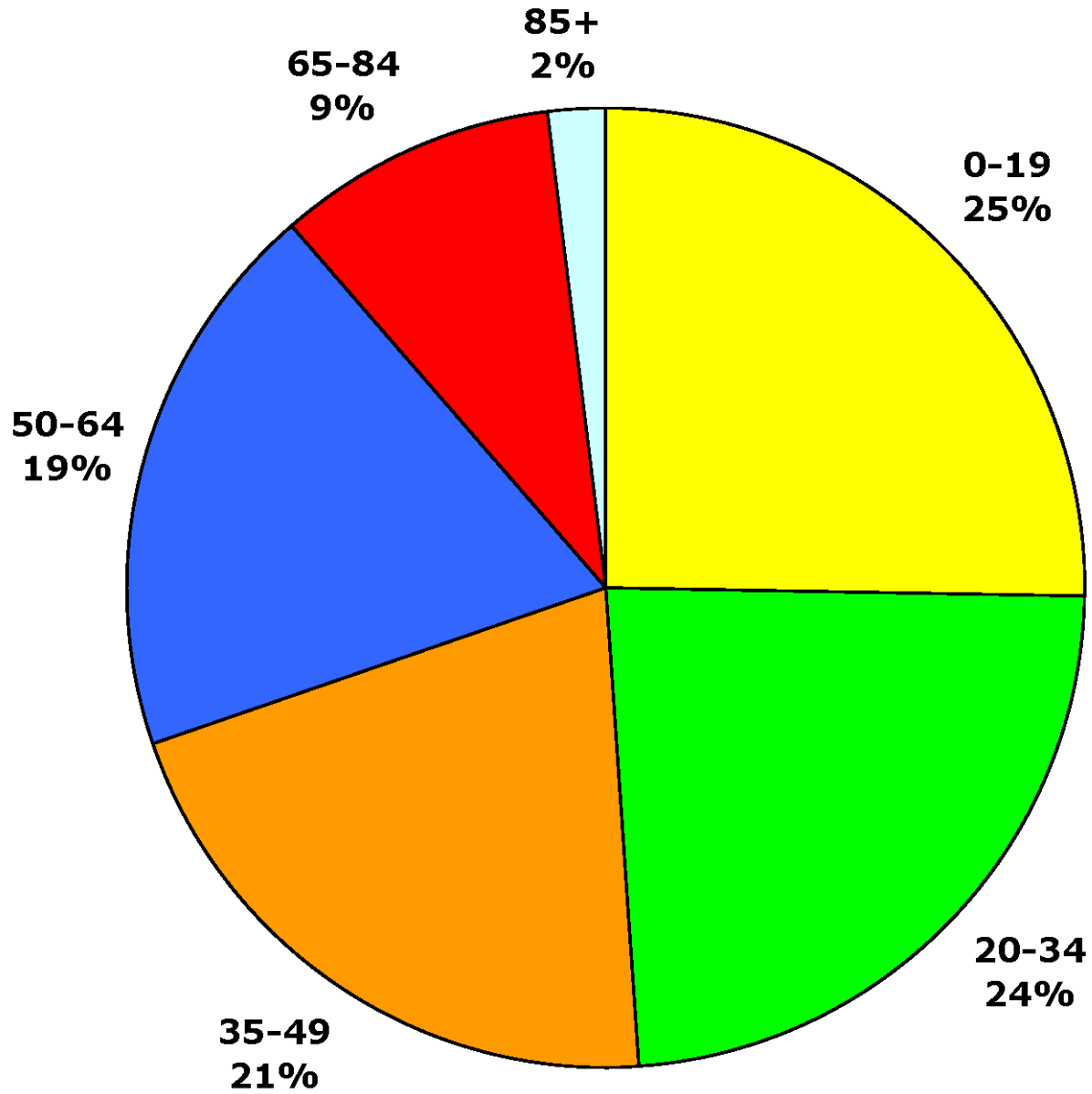

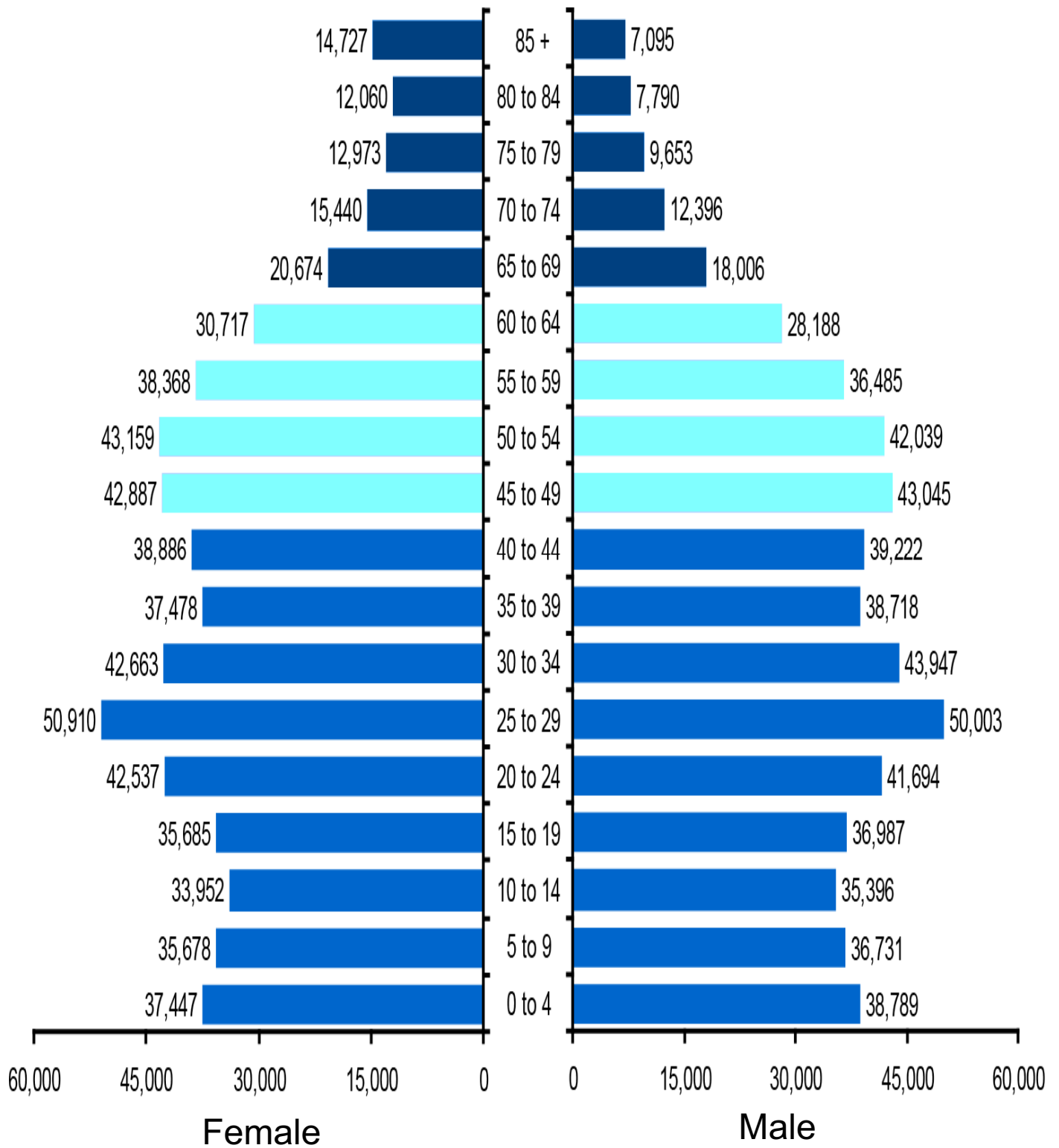

Hennepin County 2010 Population by Age Groups



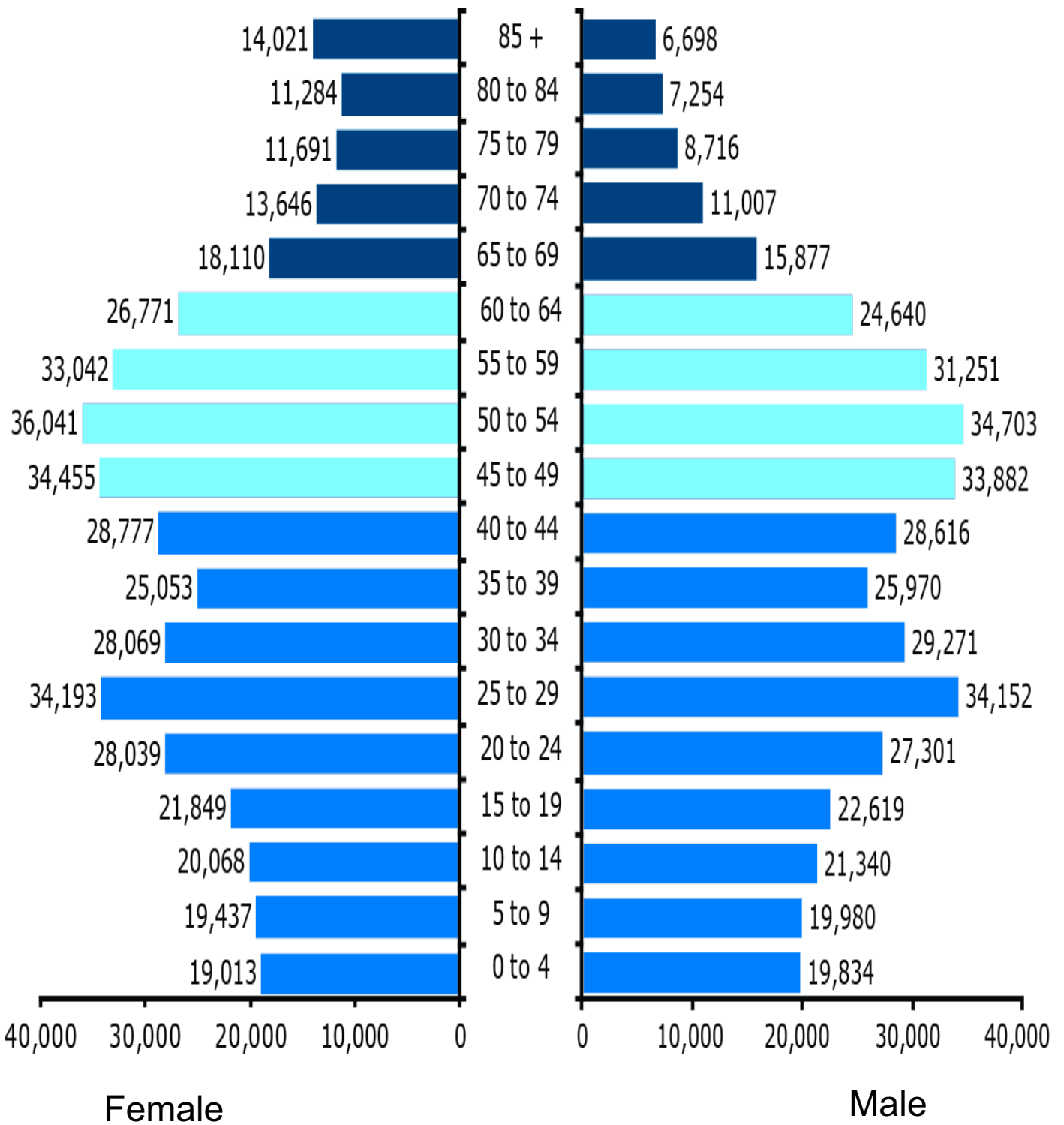

Hennepin County 2010 Population by Age & Gender



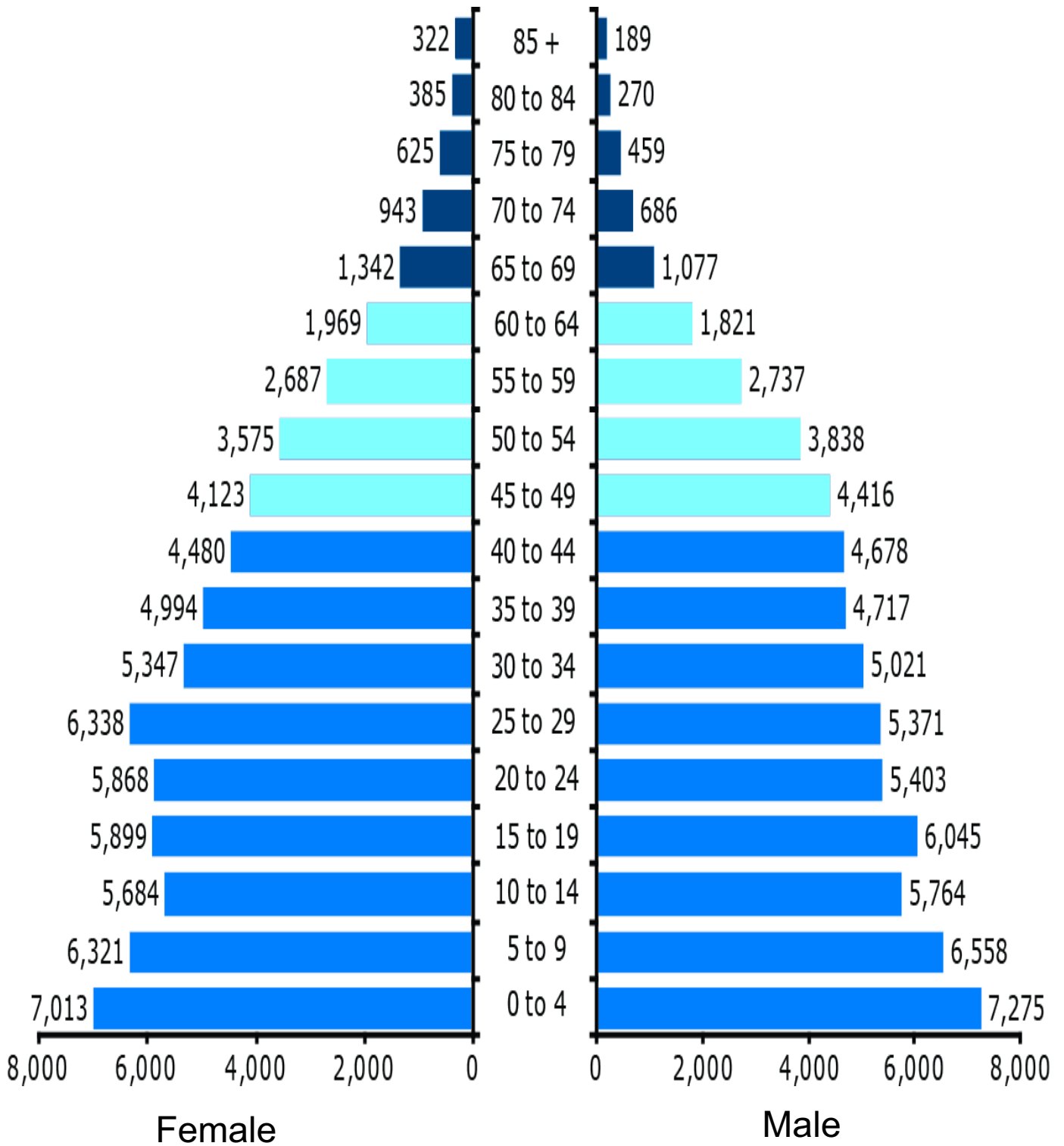

Hennepin County 2010 Population by Age & Gender White, Non-Hispanic



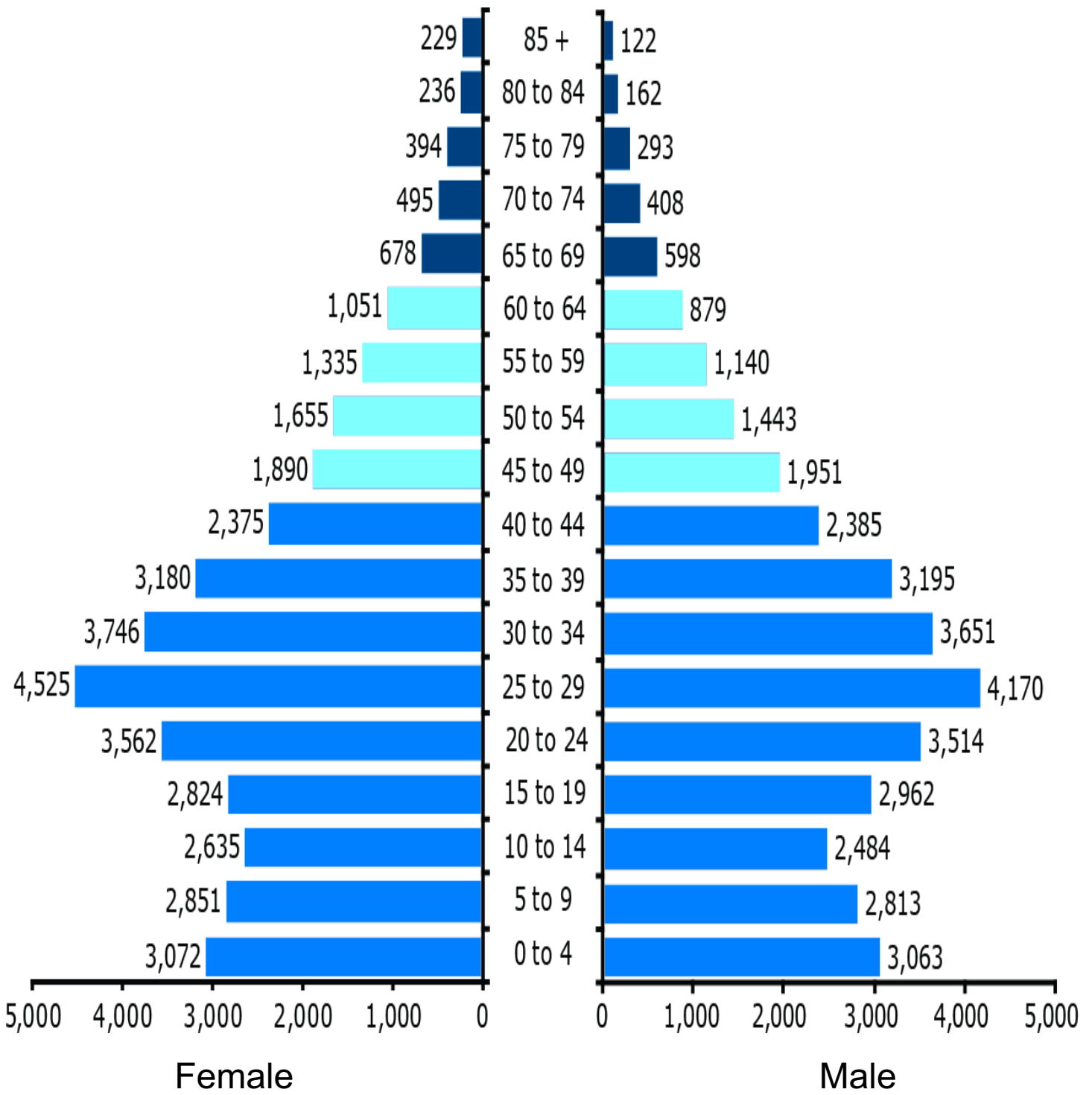

Hennepin County 2010 Population by Age & Gender Black or African American



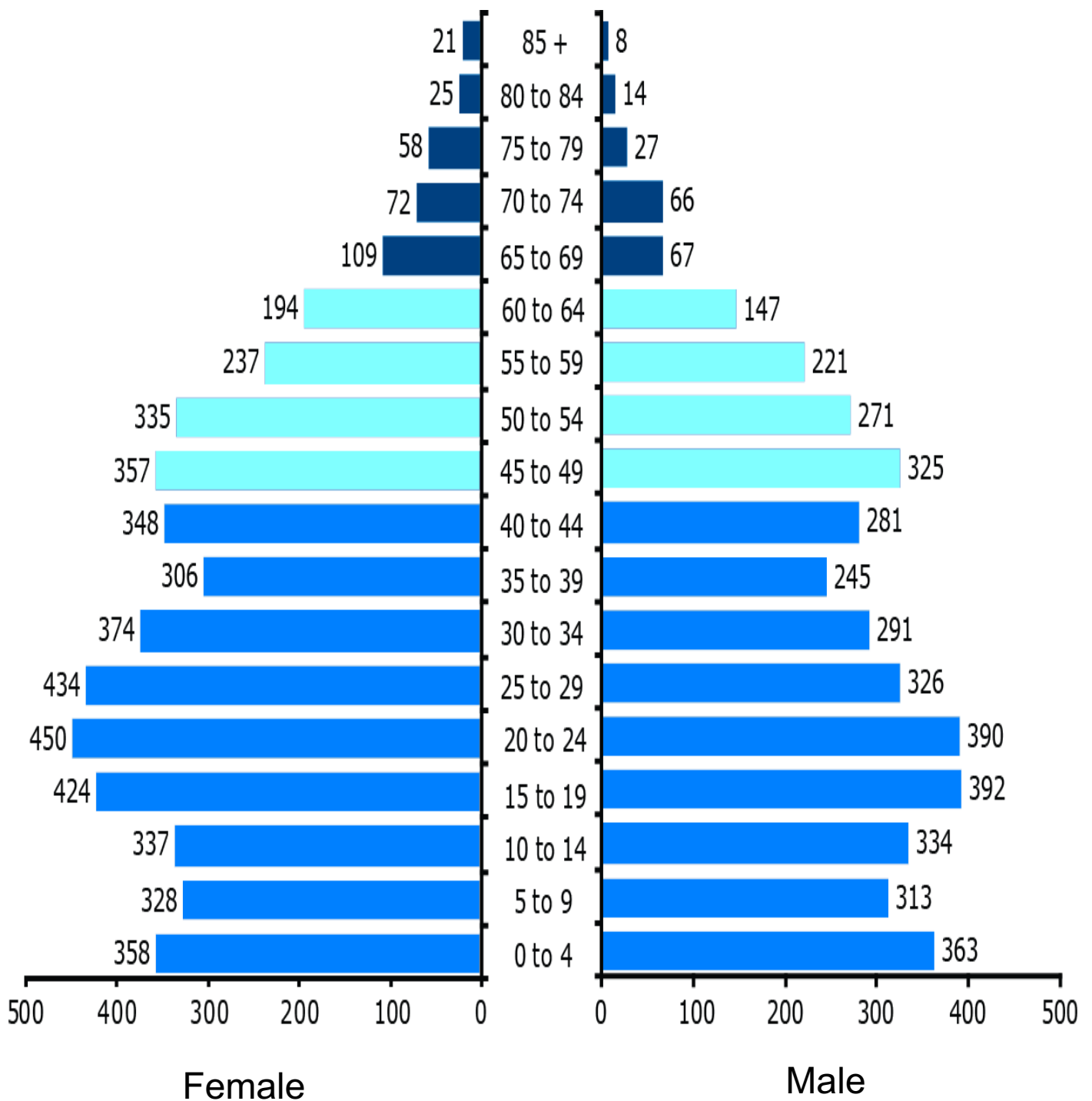

Hennepin County 2010 Population by Age & Gender Asian and Pacific Islander



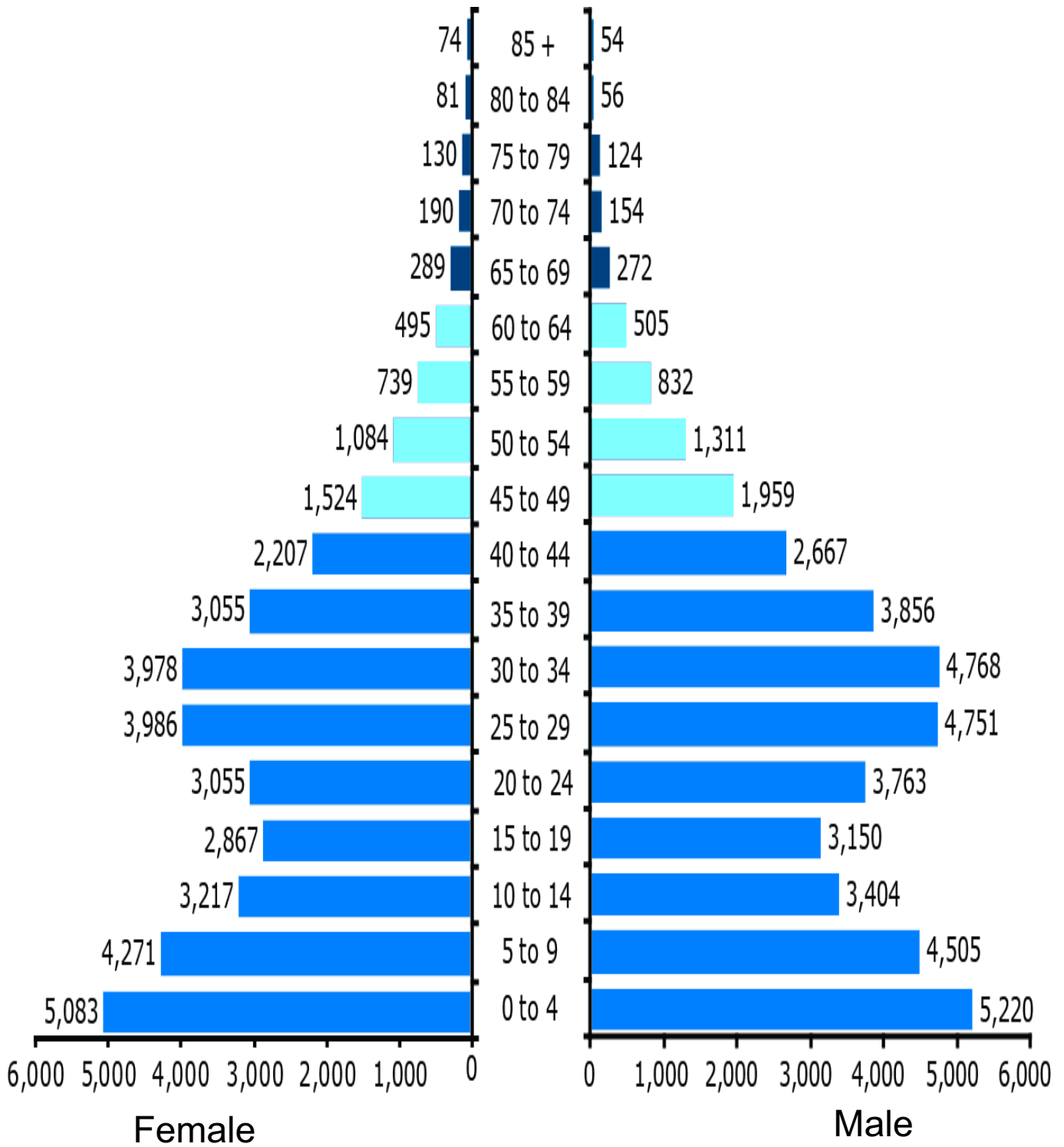

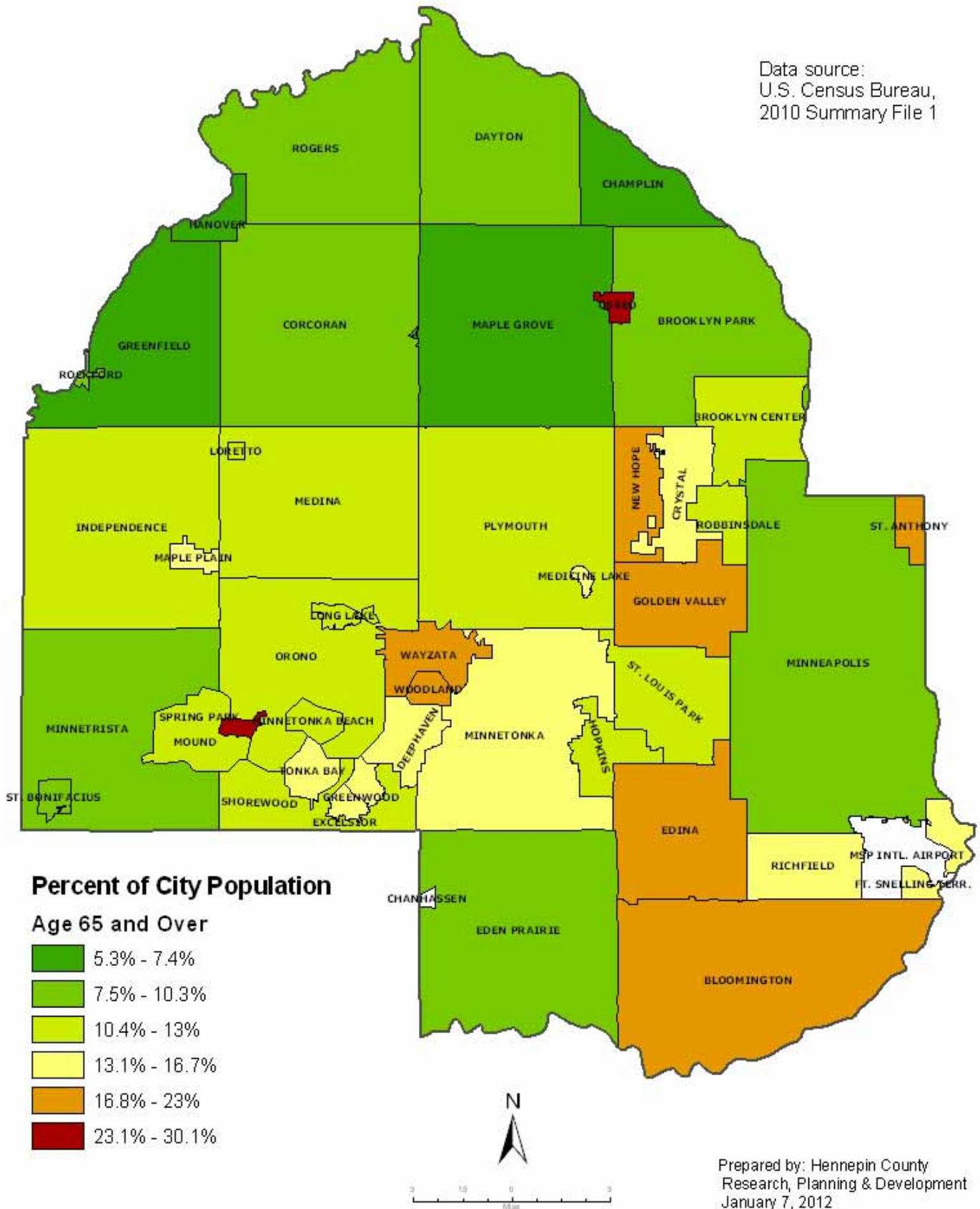
Hennepin County 2010 Population by Age & Gender Hispanic or Latino

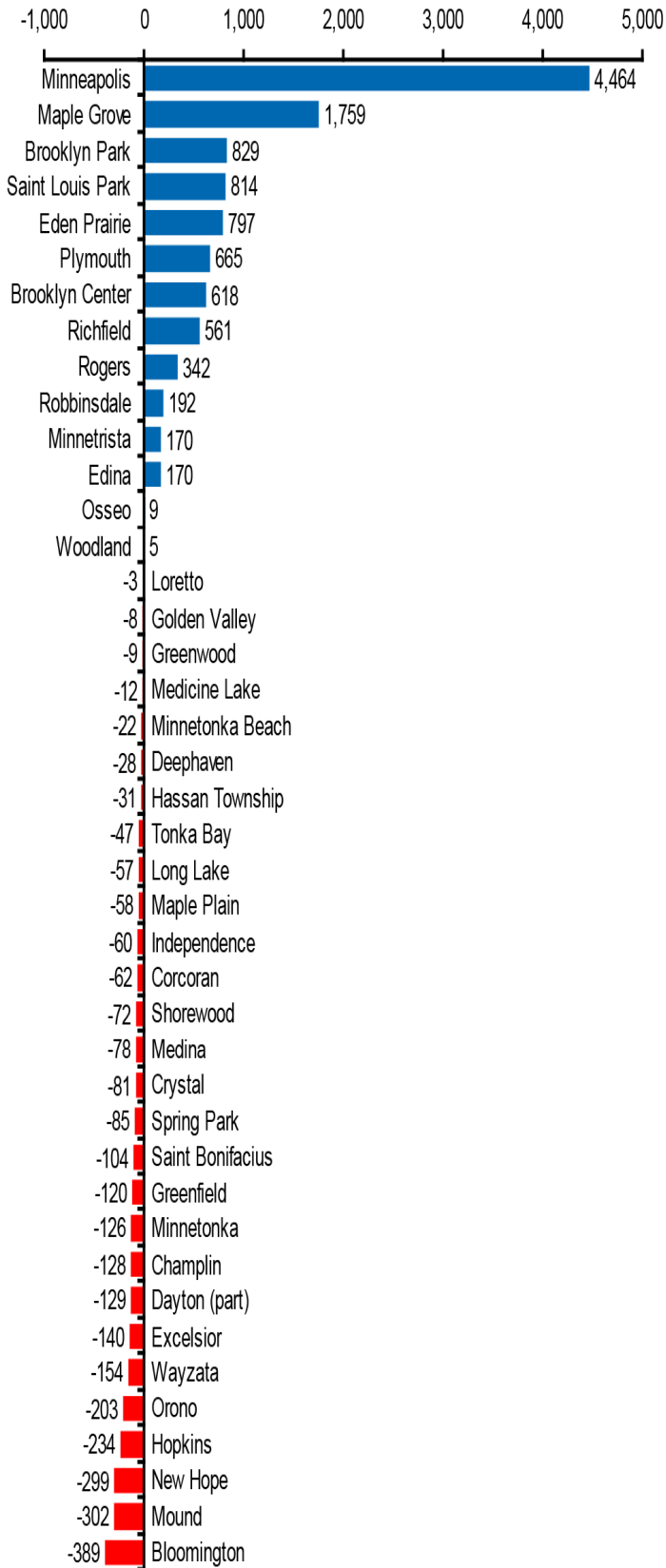

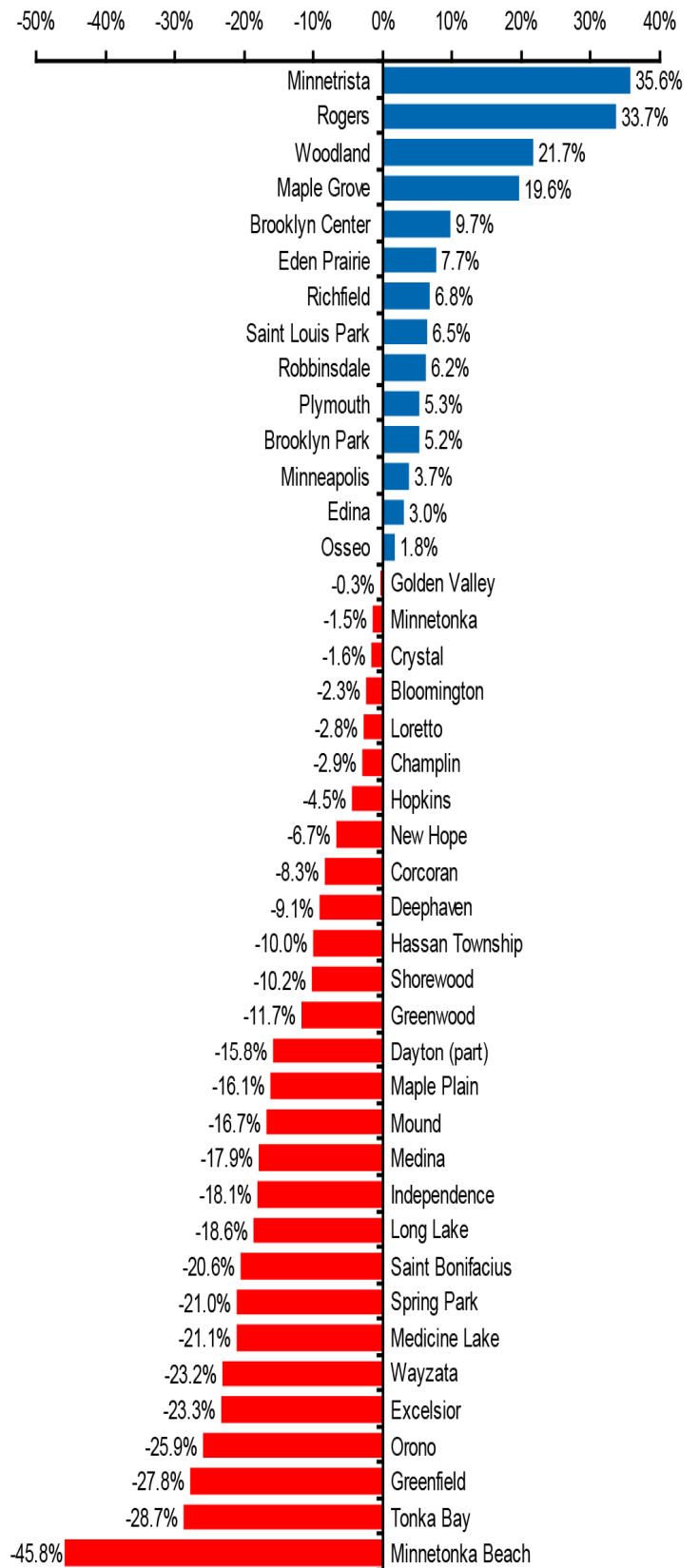

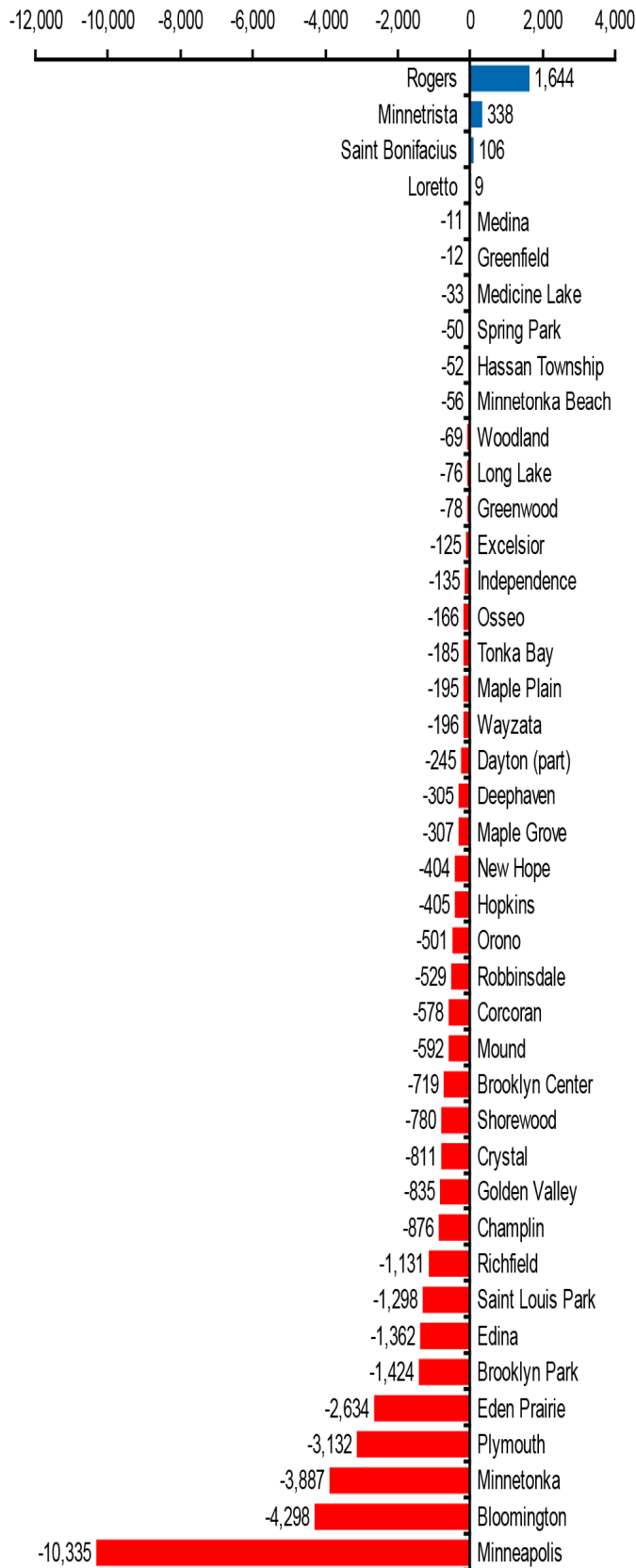
Population change 2000-2010 in ages 20 to 34



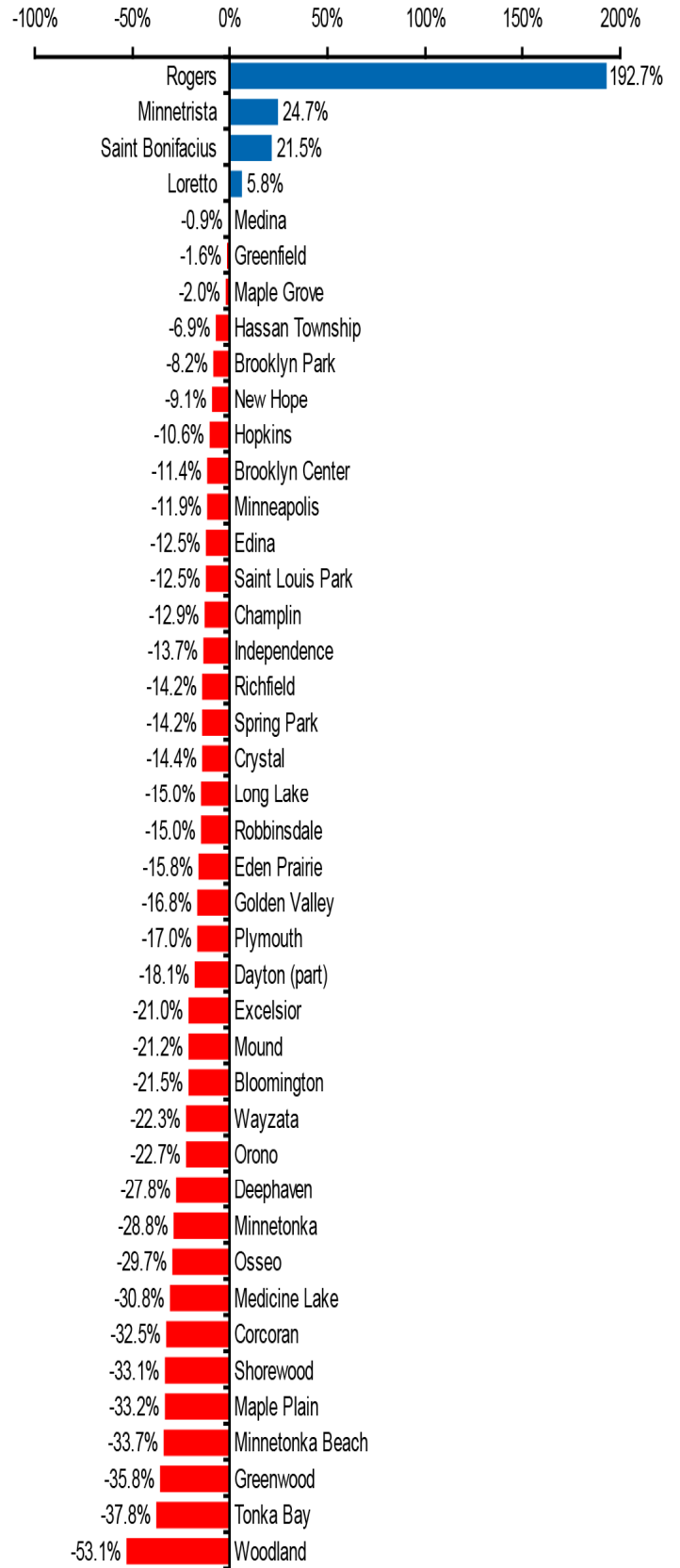
Percent change 2000-2010 in population ages 20 to 34



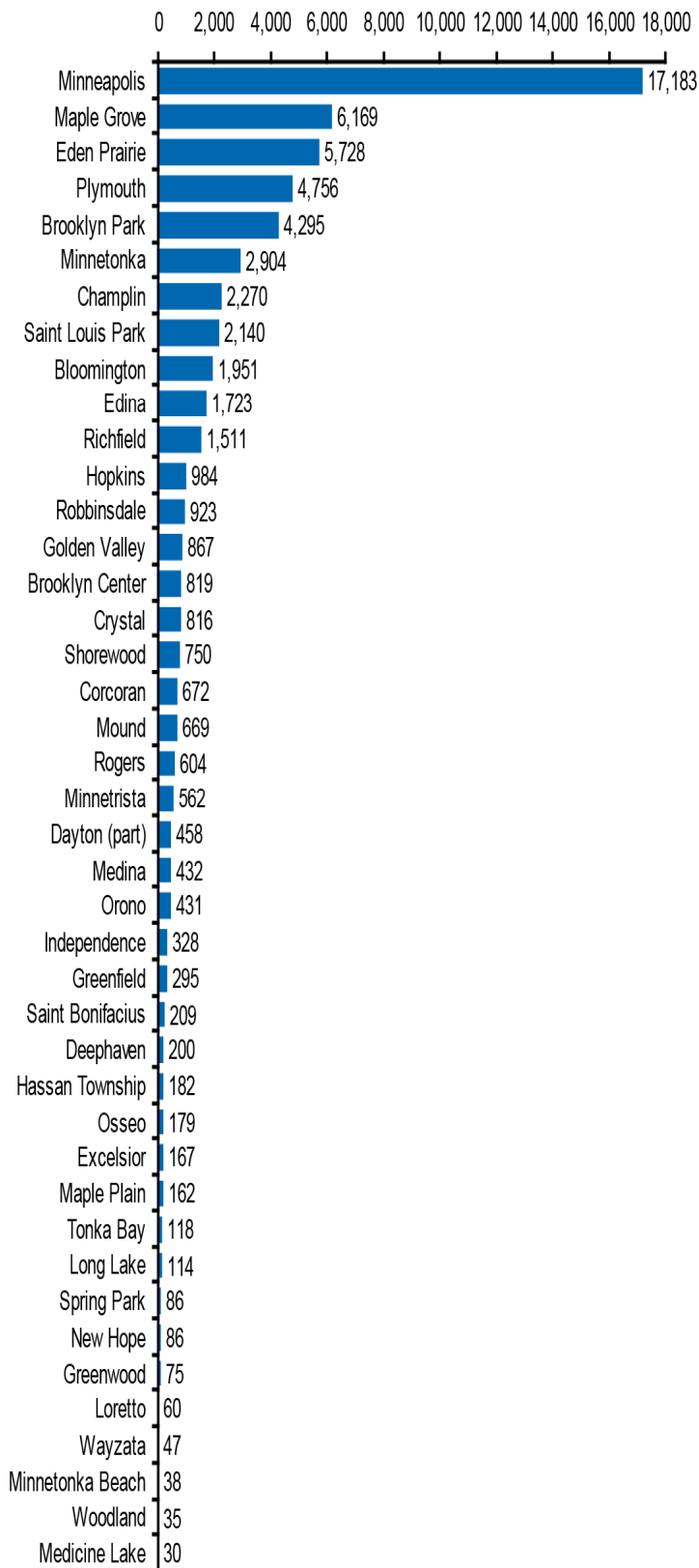
Population change 2000-2010 in ages 35 to 49



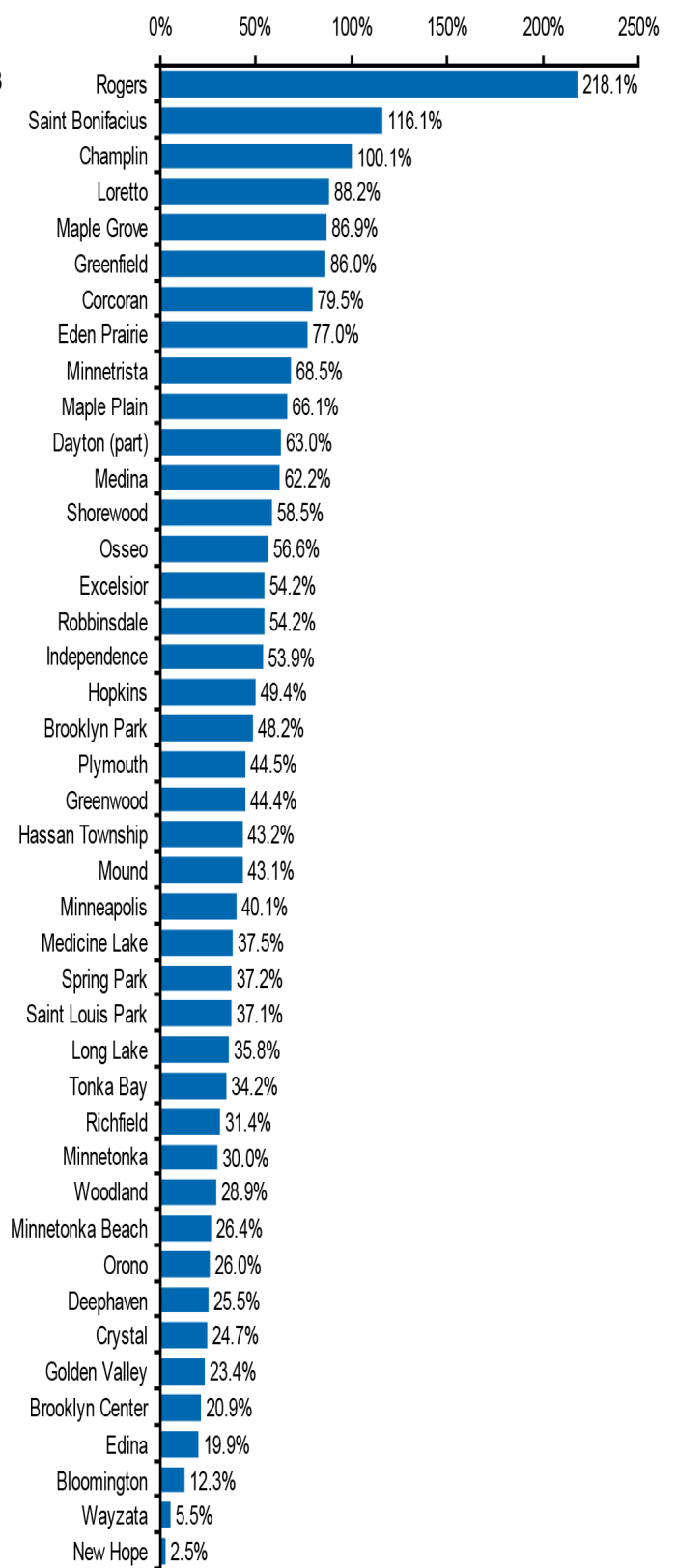
Percent change 2000-2010 in population ages 35 to 49



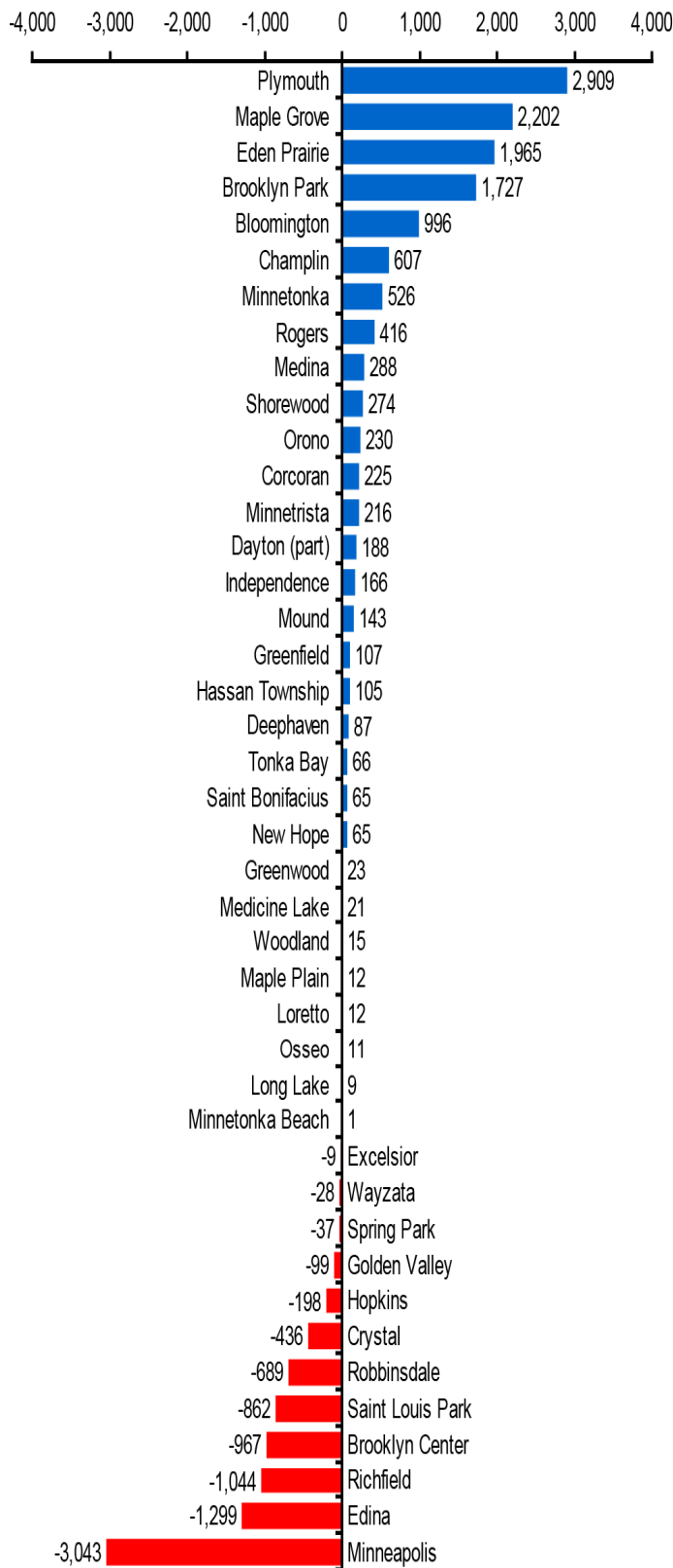
Population change 2000-2010 in ages 50 to 64



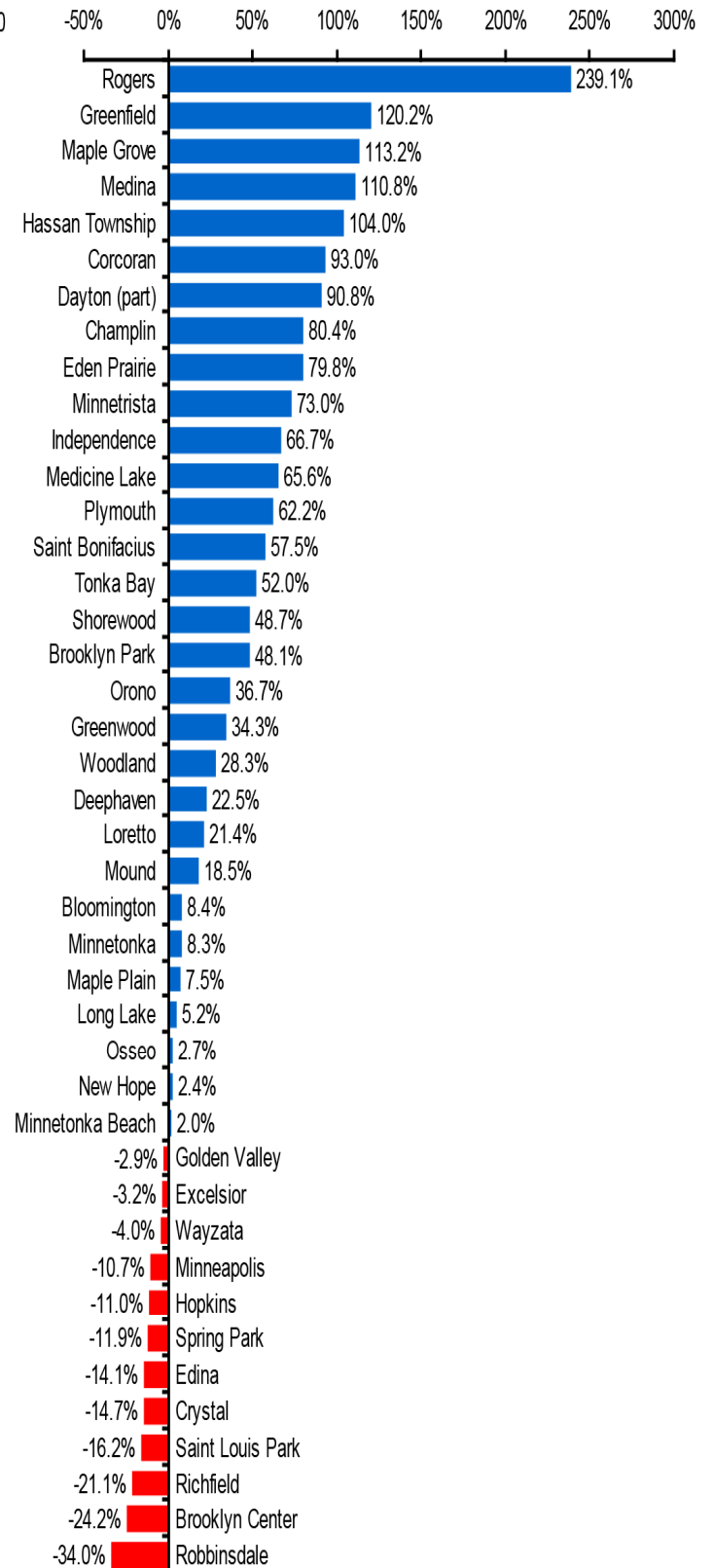
Percent change 2000-2010 in population ages 50 to 64



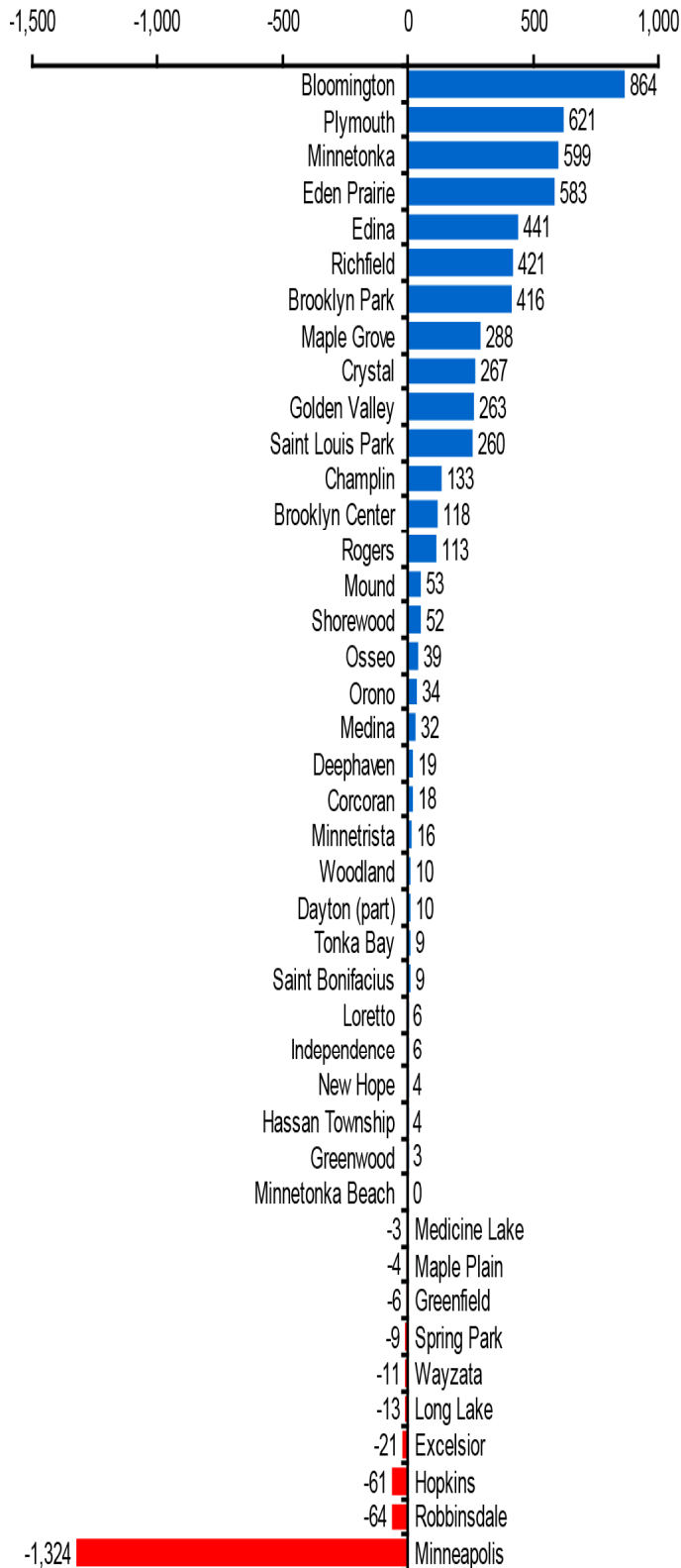
Population change 2000-2010 in ages 65 to 84



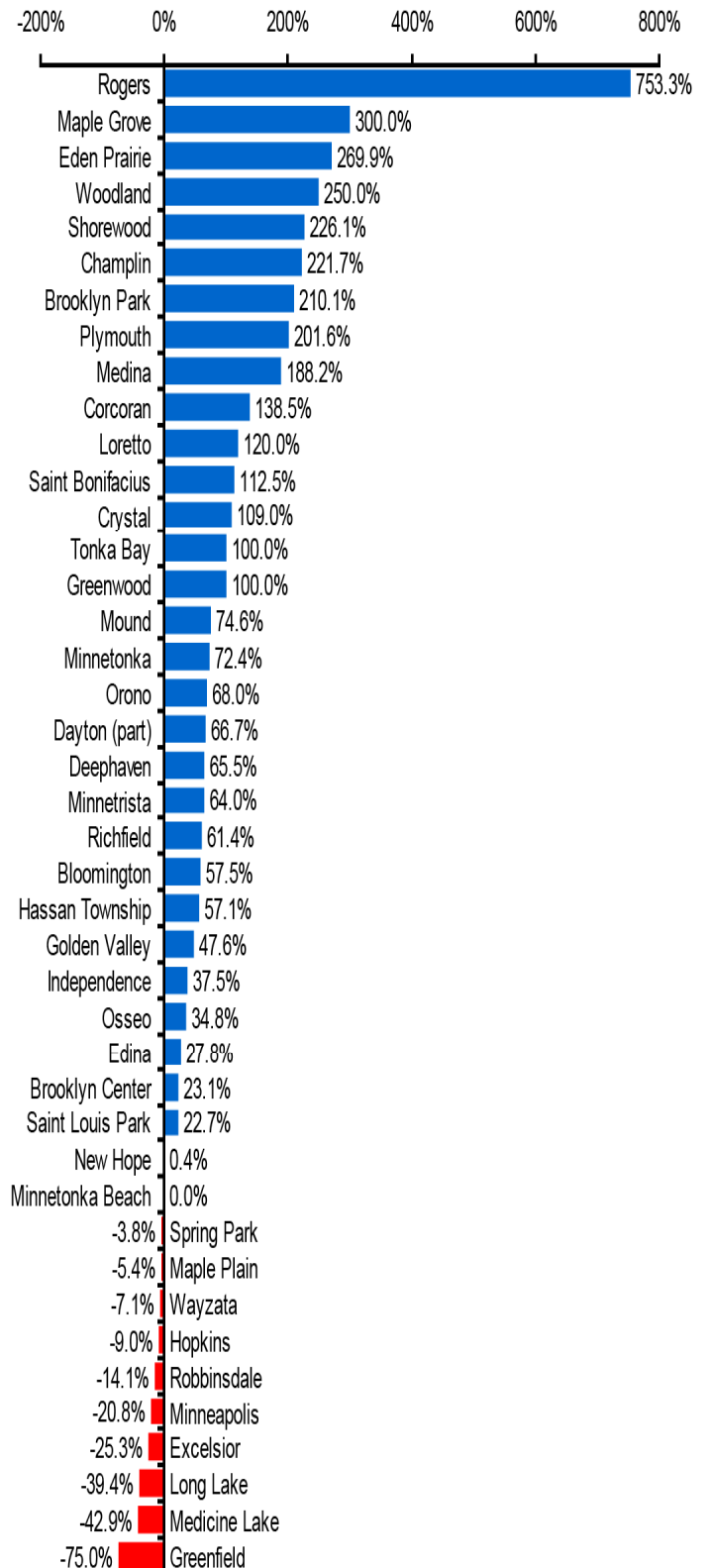
Percent change 2000-2010 in population ages 65 to 84



Population change 2000-2010 in ages 85 & over

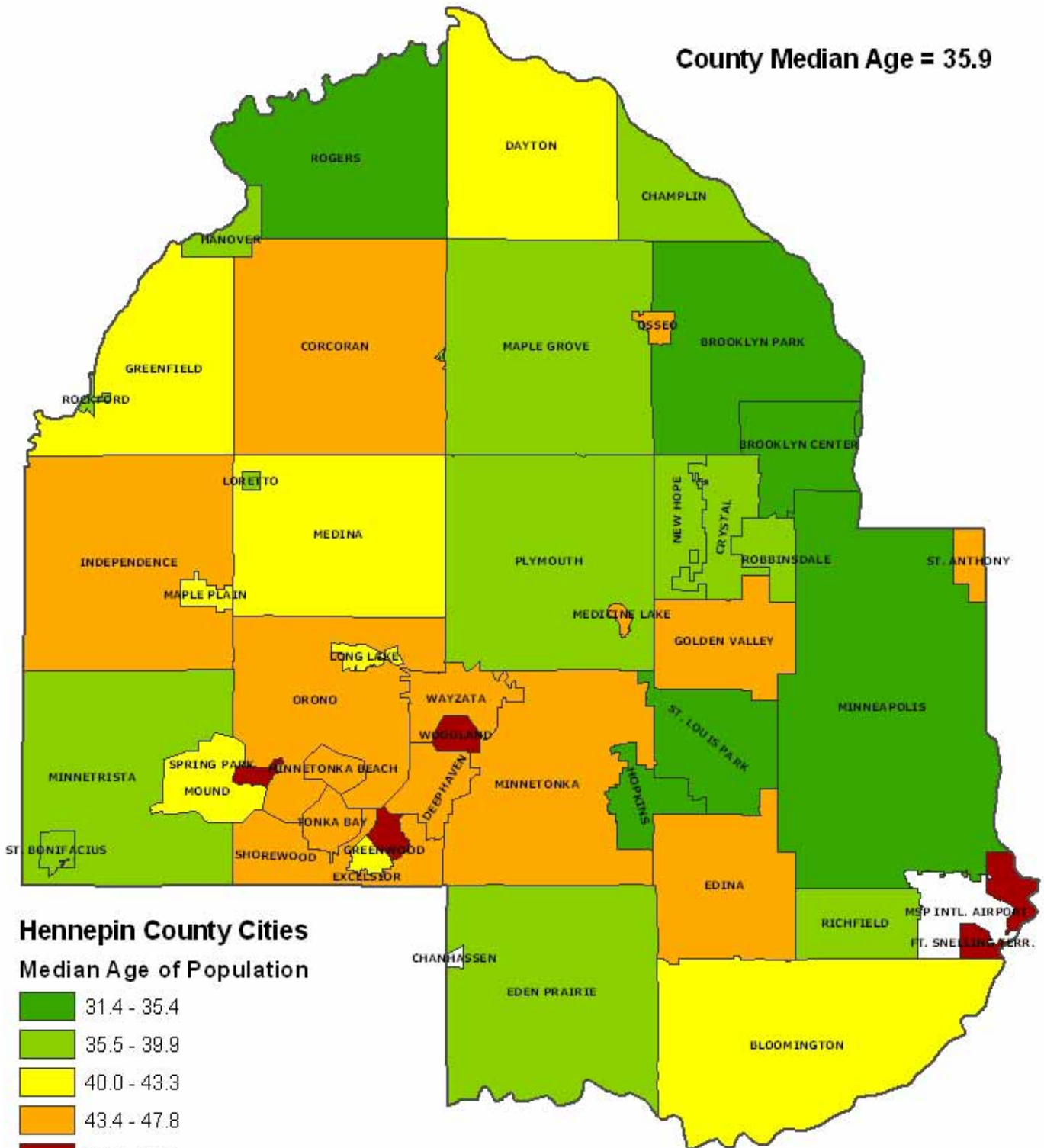


Percent change 2000-2010 in population ages 85 & over

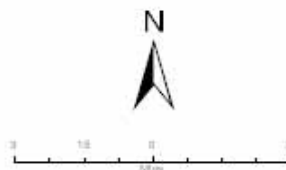


Median Age of Population by City, 2010 Census

Major Summary Points

- Baby Boomers comprise 26% of county's pop.
- Eighty-four percent of Boomers are White
- Eleven percent of the county is age 65 or older
- Minneapolis, Eden Prairie, and the cities in the northern part of the county have the smallest proportions of people age 65 and older
- Median age of the county pop. is 35.9 years
- Only 7 cities have a lower median age than 35.9
- Minneapolis is young (31.4) and holds down the county's median age
- Many western suburbs have a median age of 43 years or older
